

## Cable Fingerless Gloves

Fits average sized ladies' hands

**Gauge:** 15sts to 10cm in stocking stitch – gauge is important as it will change the finished size of the glove. It is recommended to work a tension square first.

**Materials:** 1 x 50 gram ball Plassard primo 12ply, 1 set 5.5mm straight knitting needles, 1 tapestry needle.

**Abbreviations:** k=knit, p=purl, CF2=cable 2 sts to front, CB2=cable 2 sts to back, make 1= make 1 stitch, rpt=repeat,

**Pattern Notes:** Instructions are given for right- and left-hand glove.



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### Instructions:

#### **Right Hand**

Cast on 28

**Row 1:** K1, P1

**Rows 2 – 12:** Rpt row 1 - Total 12 rows rib

**Row 13:** K3 p1, k4, p1, Knit to end

**Row 14:** purl to last 9 sts k1 p4 k1 p3

#### **Increase for thumb**

**Row 15:** K3 p1, CF2, p1, k4, make 1, k2, make 1, knit to end 30 sts

**Row 16:** rpt row 14

**Row 17:** K3 p1 k4 p1 k4, make 1, k4, make 1, knit to end 32 sts

**Row 19:** Rpt row 14

**Row 20:** K3 p1 CB2 p1 k4, make 1, k6, make 1, knit to end 34 sts

**Row 21:** rpt row 14

**Row 22:** K3 p1 k4 p1 k4, make 1, k8, make 1, knit to end 36 sts

**Row 23:** rpt row 14

**Row 24:** K3 p1, CF2, p1, k4, make 1, k10, make 1, knit to end 38 sts

**Row 25:** rpt row 14

**Row 26:** K3 p1 k4 p1 k4, make 1, k10, make 1, knit to end 40 sts

**Row 27:** p26 turn

**Row 28:** k12 turn

Now working on 12 sts for thumb only

**Row 1 (thumb):** purl

**Row 2 (thumb):** knit

**Row 3:** purl

**Rows 4 - 5 (thumb):** k1 p1

Cast off.

With of wrong side of work facing reattach yarn sts on left hand needle, P5, k1, p4, 1, p3

**Row 29:** K3 p1 k4 p1 knit to end, 28 sts

**Row 30:** rpt row 14

**Row 31:** K3 p1 CB2 p1 knit to end.

**Row 32:** rpt row 14

**Row 33:** K3 p1 k4, p1 knit to end.

**Row 34:** rpt row 14

**Row 35:** K3 p1 CB2 p1 knit to end.

**Row 36:** rpt row 14

**Rows 37– 40:** k1, p1

Cast off in rib

Sew any gaps around base of thumb, sew side seam, trim and neaten loose ends.



### **Left Hand**

Cast on 28

**Row 1:** K1, P1

**Rows 2 – 12:** Rpt row 1 - Total 12 rows rib

**Row 13:** knit to last 9 sts, p1, k4, p1, k3

**Row 14:** p3, k1 p4 k1 purl to end of row

#### **Increase for thumb**

**Row 15:** k13, make 1, k2, make 1, k4, p1, cf2, p1, k3 30 sts

**Row 16:** rpt row 14

**Row 17:** K13, make 1, k4, make 1, k4, p1, k4, p1, k3 32 sts

**Row 19:** Rpt row 14

**Row 20;** k13, make 1, k6, make 1, k4, p1, cb2, p1, k3 34 sts

**Row 21:** rpt row 14

**Row 22:** k13, make 1, k8, make 1, p1, k4, p1, k3 36 sts

**Row 23;** rpt row 14

**Row 24:** k13, make 1, k10, make 1, k4, p1, cf2, p1, k3 38 sts

**Row 25:** rpt row 14

**Row 26:** k13, make 1, k12, make 1, k4, p1, k4, p1, k3 40 sts

**Row 27:** p3, k1, p4, k1, p17, turn

**Row 28:** k12, turn,

Now working on 12 sts for thumb only

**Row 1 (thumb):** purl

**Row 2 (thumb):** knit

**Row 3 (thumb):** purl

**Row 4 and 5(thumb):** k1, p1

Cast off.

With of wrong side of work facing reattach yarn sts on left hand needle and purl these 14 sts

**Row 29:** k19 sts, p1, cb2, p1, k3

**Row 30:** rpt row 14

**Row 31:** k19 sts, p1, k4, p1, k3

**Row 32:** rpt row 14

**Row 33:** k19 sts, p1, cf2, p1, k3

**Row 34:** rpt row 14

**Row 35:** rpt row 29

**Row 36:** rpt row 14

**Rows 37 – 40:** k1, p1

Finish as for right hand.
