Knitted Bath Set -easy knitting

Materials: Yarn Club Bamboo Cotton 8ply 50gram x 2 balls, a set of 3.75mm knitting needles and yarn needle

Abbreviations: k=knit, p=purl, kpk=knit pul knit in same stitch, YO= yarn over, p2tog= purl 2 sts together, p3tog=purl 3 sts together, k2tog= knit 2 sts together, kfb=knit front and back of st, pfb= purl front and back of next st, st=stitch, sts=stitches, RS=right side, WS=wrong side

Gauge: 21 sts x 38 rows = 10cm x 10cm square

BATH SCRUBBY

Stitch Pattern:

Row 1 (RS): k2tog, k27, kfb Row 2: kfb, k27, k2tog Row 3: p2tog, P27, pfb Row 4: kfb, k27, k2tog Keeping A attached to work, switch to B Row 5: k2tog, k 27, kfb Row 6: pfb, p27, p2tog

Instructions:

Cast on 30 stitches, leaving a long tail.

Follow the 6 pattern rows above x 7 times, for a total of 42 rows. Bind off leaving a long tail. Put the right sides of bath scrubby together and use long tail to sew bottom edge to top edge of knitting. Work in remaining tail to hide. Turn bath scrubby right side out, and gather each edge then pass one tail end through the centre hole of the bath scrubby and tie as tightly as possible to the tail on that side. Pass through the middle again and tie on the other side. Work yarn ends into inside of bath scrubby.

Star Wash Cloth

Cast On 14 stitches and knit back

Knit 4, yarn over, knit, leaving 2 stitches and knit back
Knit 4, yarn over, knit, leaving 4 stitches and knit back
Knit 4, yarn over, knit, leaving 6 stitches and knit back
Knit 4, yarn over, knit, leaving 8 stitches and knit back
Cast off 4 and knit to end – knit back (should be 14 stitches on the needle)

Repeat 1 -5 thirteen times, giving a total of 14 points to the star shape.

Leave enough yarn to sew sides together and go around circle and draw circle together. Tie ends in a double knot. Trim and neaten any loose ends.

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FACE WASHER

Cast on 43 sts Work 5 rows seed stitch (k1, P1) Now work as for soap bag below, however work 5 sts on each edge in seed instead of the 3 sts as for soap bag. Repeat for 6 patt repeats. The work rows 1 to 6 once Knit 1 row Work 5 rows seed stitch cast off. Trim and neaten ends

SOAP BAG

(make 2) Cast on 15 sts Row 1: k1, p1 Rpt row 1 - three times Commence main pattern. Row 1 (RS): k1 p1 k1, knit to last 3, k1 p1 k1 Row 2: k1 p1 k1, purl to last 3sts, k1 p1 k1 **Row 3:** k1 p1 k1, *p2 k1* to last 3 sts, k1 p1 k1 **Row 4:** k1 p1 k1 *k2 p2* to last 3 sts, k1 p1 k1 Row 5: as row 1 Row 6: as row 2 **Row 7:** k1 p1 k1 *k1, kpk, k1* to last 3 k1 p1 k1 **Row 8:** k1 p1 k1 *p1 p3tog p1* to last 3 sts k1 p1 k1 Rpt rows 1 – 8 a further 3 times Next Row: k1 p1 k1, knit to last 3, k1 p1 k1 Next Row: k1 p1 k1, purl to last 3sts, k1 p1 k1 Next Row: k1, p1 Rpt last row twice Next Row (WS): k1 p1 k1 yo p2tog p1 yo k2tog k1 yo p2tog p1 yo k2tog k1 Next Row: k1, p1 Rpt last row three times, cast off.

Assembly: place the 2 pieces right sides together and sew side and base of bag seams, trim and neaten edges. Thread some ribbon or cord threw eyelets at top of bag.



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
