

Crochet Leaves Scarf - easy crochet

Materials: Cotton Silk Tweed 100g x 1 (M), YC Giza Sport 50g x 2 balls (C) a 4.5mm crochet hook and yarn needle

Abbreviations: ch=chain, dc=double crochet, sl st=slip stitch, st/s=stitch/es, rep=repeat, tr=treble, sk=skip rnds=rounds, sp/s=space/s

Gauge: not critical

NOTES:

- Weave in loose ends as work progresses.
- Join with slip stitch as indicated unless otherwise stated.
- Chain-3 at beginning of row counts as first double crochet unless otherwise stated.

Special Stitches

Small shell (sm shell): (Dc, ch 1, dc) in indicated sp.

STRIP 1

With M, ch 5, join (see Pattern Notes) to first ch to form a ring.

Row 1: Ch 3 (see Pattern Notes), tr in ring, ch 5, 2 tr in ring, turn. (4 tr, 1 ch-5 sp)

Row 2: Ch 3, tr in next tr, ch 2, sk next 2 chs, sm shell (see Special Stitches) in next ch, ch 2, sk next 2 chs, tr in next tr, tr in 3rd ch, turn. (4 tr, 1 sm shell, 2 ch-2 sps)

Row 3: Ch 3, tr in next tr, ch 3, sm shell in next sm shell, ch 3, tr in next tr, tr in 3rd ch, turn. (4 tr, 1 sm shell, 2 ch-3 sps)

Row 4: Ch 3, tr in next tr, ch 4, sm shell in next sm shell, ch 4, tr in next tr, tr in 3rd ch, turn. (4 tr, 1 sm shell, 2 ch-4 sps)

Row 5: Ch 3, tr in next tr, ch 5, sm shell in next sm shell, ch 5, tr in next tr, tr in 3rd ch, turn. (4 tr, 1 sm shell, 2 ch-5 sps)

Row 6: Ch 3, tr in next tr, ch 6, sm shell in next sm shell, ch 6, tr in next tr, tr in 3rd ch, turn. (4 tr, 1 sm shell, 2 ch-6 sps)

Row 7: Ch 3, tr in next tr, ch 7, sm shell in next sm shell, ch 7, tr in next tr, tr in 3rd ch, turn. (4 tr, 1 sm shell, 2 ch-7 sps)

Row 8: Rep row 6.

Row 9: Rep row 5.

Row 10: Rep row 4.

Row 11: Rep row 3.

Row 12: Ch 3, tr in next tr, ch 2, sm shell in next sm shell, ch 2, tr in next tr, tr in 3rd ch, turn. (4 tr, 1 sm shell, 2 ch-2 sps)

Row 13: Ch 3, tr in each of next 2 tr, tr in 3rd ch, turn. (4 tr)

Row 14: Ch 3, tr in next tr, ch 5, tr in next tr, tr in 3rd ch, turn. (4 tr, 1 ch-5 sp)

Rep [rows 2–14] 9 times.

Turn your work around to work on side of strip.

Rnd 1: *[Ch 5, sk next ch-3 sp or tr, dc in next ch-3 sp or tr] rep until first ch-5 ring, 3 dc in ring; rep from * on other side, fasten off

Measurements (approximate):

200cm long x 55cm at widest point



STRIP 2

Row 1: With C, work as for Strip 1.

Rows 2–14: Rep [rows 2–14 as for Strip 1] 8 times.

Join Strips

Turn your work around.

Start working on side of strip to join to previous strip.

Rnd 1: [Ch 5, sk next 3 ch-5 sps from top of previous strip, dc in next ch-5 sp on previous strip, ch 5, sk next ch-3 sp or tr on working strip, dc in next ch-3 sp or tr] rep until last join, (You should have 3 ch-5 sps left at end of previous strip), [ch 5, sk next ch-3 sp or tr on working strip, dc in next ch-3 sp or tr] rep until first ch-5 ring, 3 dc in ring, fasten off.

STRIP 3

Row 1: With M, work as for Strip 1.

Rows 2–14: Rep [rows 2–14 as for Strip 1] 7 times. Work round 1 of strip 2 to join strip 3 to strip 2.

STRIP 4

Row 1: With C, work as for Strip 1.

Rows 2–14: Rep [rows 2–14 as for Strip 1] 6 times. Work round 1 of strip 2 to join strip 4 to strip 3.

STRIP 5

Row 1: With M, work as for Strip 1.

Rows 2–14: Rep [rows 2–14 as for Strip 1] 6 times. Work round 1 of strip 2 to join strip 5 to strip 4.

Finishing

Block wrap to open lace.
