YARN

- 2, 2, 2, 3 balls 50gm Loyal Tweed
 DK colour A #1007
- 1, 2, 2, 2 balls 50gm Loyal Tweed DK colour B #1006
- 2, 2, 2, 2 balls 50gm Loyal Tweed DK colour C #1001
- 2, 2, 3, 3 balls 50gm Loyal Tweed DK colour D #1002
- 2, 2, 2, 2 balls 50gm Loyal Tweed DK colour E #1004
- 4 (4, 5, 5) buttons

NEEDLES AND TOOLS

- 3.75mm knitting needles
- 4.00mm knitting needles
- Stitch holders and markers

MEASUREMENTS

To fit chest 56, 61, 66, 71cm Finished fit 64, 70, 76, 80cm Garment length 38, 41, 45, 50cm Sleeve length 23, 25.5, 28, 34cm

TENSION

22 sts by 30 rows over Stocking st on 4.00mm needles to 10cm

GETTING STARTED MITRED SQUARE I (MAKE 4)

With 4.00mm needles and A, cast on 72 (78, 84, 90) sts.

Foundation row: WS – A, k all sts and mark centre of row.

Row 1: RS – A, k34 (37, 40, 43) sts, k2tog, skp, k34 (37, 40, 43) sts. 70 (76, 82, 88) sts.

Row 2: WS - A, k all sts.

Row 3: A, k to 2 sts before marker, k2tog, skp, k to end.

Row 4: A, k all sts.

Rows 5 and 7: A, k to 2 sts before marker, k2tog, skp, k to end.

Row 6: A, p all sts.

Row 8: A, k all sts.

Rows 9, 11 and 13: B, k to 2 sts before marker, k2tog, skp, k to end.

Rows 10 and 12: B, k all sts.

Row 14: B, p all sts.

Row 15: C, k to 2 sts before marker, k2tog, skp, k to end.

Row 16: C, p all sts.

Rows 17 and 19: B, k to 2 sts before marker, k2tog, skp, k to end.

Rows 18 and 20: B, k all sts.

Rows 21 and 23: C, k to 2 sts before marker, k2tog, skp, k to end.

Rows 22 and 24: C, p all sts.

Rows 25 and 27: C, k to 2 sts before marker, k2tog, skp, k to end.

Rows 26 and 28: C, k all sts.

Rows 29 and 31: D, k to 2 sts before marker, k2tog, skp, k to end.

Row 30: D, k all sts.

Row 32: D, p all sts.

Rows 33, 35 and 37: D, k to 2 sts before marker, k2tog, skp, k to end.

Rows 34 and 36: D, k all sts.

Row 38: D, p all sts.

Rows 39, 41, 43 and 45: E, k to 2 sts before marker, k2tog, skp, k to end.

Row 40: E, p all sts.

Row 42: E, k all sts.

Row 44: E, p all sts.

Row 46: E, k all sts.

Rows 47 and 49: A, k to 2 sts before marker, k2tog, skp, k to end.

Row 48: A, k all sts.

Row 50: A, p all sts.

Rows 51 and 53: E, k to 2 sts before marker, k2tog, skp, k to end.

Row 52: E, p all sts.

Row 54: E, k all sts.

Rows 55, 57, 59, 61 and 63: B, k to 2 sts before marker, k2tog, skp, k to end.

Row 56: B, k all sts.

Rows 58, 60 and 62: B, p all sts. Row 64: B, k all sts. 8 (14, 20, 26)

sts.

Sizes 61, 66, 71 only

Rows 65, 67 and 69: D, k to 2 sts before marker, k2tog, skp, k to end.

Row 66: D, k all sts.

Rows 68 and 70: D, p all sts. 8 (14, 20) sts.

Sizes 66, 71 only

Rows 71, 73 and 75: A, k to 2 sts before marker, k2tog, skp, k to end.

Rows 72 and 74: A, k all sts. Row 76: A, p all sts. 8 (14) sts.

Size 71 only

Rows 77, 79 and 81: B, k to 2 sts before marker, k2tog, skp, k to end.

Row 78: B, k all sts.

Rows 80 and 82: B, p all sts. 8 sts.

Complete All Sizes (8 sts remaining

for every size now)

Next Row: RS - C, k to 2 sts before

marker, k2tog, skp, k to end.

Next Row: C, k all sts.

Next Row: C, k1, k2tog, skp, k1. 4

sts.

Next Row: C, p all sts.

Next Row: C, k2tog, skp. 2 sts.

Next Row: C, p2tog.

Fasten off.

MITRED SQUARE II (MAKE 4)

Work as for square 1 but use:

E instead of A

A instead of B

D instead of C

C instead of D

B instead of E

STRIPE PATTERN FOR UPPER BACK & FRONTS & SLEEVES

**D, Gtst 4 rows, then Stst 6 rows.

C, Stst 4 rows, then Gtst 6 rows, then Stst 4 rows.

E, Stst 6 rows.

B, Gtst 4 rows, then Stst 4 rows.

A, Stst 4 rows, then Gtst 4 rows, then Stst 4 rows.

E, Stst 6 rows.**

Rep from ** to ** throughout for Stripe pattern.





Mitred Squares & Stripes Coat continued

WORKING PATTERN BACK

With RS facing, place 2 squares of I and 2 squares of II on flat surface in front of you with the fasten off points meeting at centre and I and I and II and II across from each other (not above each other). (the cast on edge of each of the 4 squares is facing outwards)

Join squares neatly, ensure seam has ease and does not pull in.

These 4 squares form the lower part of the back.

With RS facing, 4.00mm needles and D, pick up and k 36 (39, 42, 45) sts across each of the 2 upper squares. 72 (78, 84, 90) sts.

Next Row: WS – D, k all sts. Work in Stripe Pattern until striped section measures 12.5 (13.5, 14.5, 15.5)cm from pick up row, end with a WS row.

Cast off 8 (9, 10, 11) sts beg next 4 rows, then 9 sts beg next 2 rows. Leave rem 22 (24, 26, 28) sts on holder for neckband.

LEFT FRONT

With RS facing, place 2 squares, one each of I & 2 on flat surface in front of you (ensure these 2 are facing in same way as the two right hand squares of back) with the fasten off points meeting at centre and two the left (the cast on edges are facing outwards and to the right).

Join squares neatly, ensure seam has ease and does not pull in.

These 2 squares form the lower part of the left front.

With RS facing, 4.00mm needles and D, pick up and k 36 (39, 42, 45) sts across upper square.

Next Row: WS - D, k all sts.

Work Stripe patt until front measures 14 (14, 16, 16) rows less than back to sts on holder, end with a WS row.

Next Row: RS – Keep Stripe patt correct, k to last 7 (7, 8, 8) sts; turn, place the 7 (7, 8, 8) sts on holder; cont on rem 29 (32, 34, 37) sts only; dec 1 st at neck edge next 4 (5, 5, 6) rows.

Cont straight until front measures same as back to beg of shoulder shaping, end with a WS row.

Cast off 8 (9, 10, 11) sts beg next 2 RS rows, then rem 9 sts on following RS row.

RIGHT FRONT

With RS facing, place 2 squares, one each of I & 2 on flat surface in front of you (ensure these 2 are facing in same way as the two left hand squares of back) with the fasten off points meeting at centre and two the right (the cast on edges are facing outwards and to the left).

Join squares neatly, ensure seam has ease and does not pull in.

These 2 squares form the lower part of the right front.

With RS facing, 4.00mm needles and D, pick up and k 36 (39, 42, 45) sts across upper square.

Next Row: WS – D, k all sts. Complete right front to match left front, reversing shaping.

SLEEVES

With 3.75mm needles and D, cast on 37 (39, 43, 47) sts.

K1, p1 rib for 6 (6, 8, 8) rows. Change to 4mm needles.

Work in Stripe patt and inc 1 st each end every 9th (9th, 10th, 11th) row to 51 (55, 59, 63) sts.

Patt straight until sleeve measures 23 (25.5, 28, 34)cm from beg, end with a WS row.

Cast off loosely using same colour as last row.

MAKING UP

Join shoulders.

Neck Edging

With RS facing, 3.75mm needles and D, k the 7 (7, 8, 8) right front holder

sts, pick up and k11 (12, 13, 13) sts up neck edge, k the back neck holder 22 (24, 26, 28) sts, pick up and k11 (12, 13, 13) sts down front, k the front holder 7 (7, 8, 8) sts. 58 (62, 68, 70) sts.

Gtst 5 (5, 7, 7) rows.

Next Row: K2, k2tog, k to last 4 sts, skp, k2.

Rep last row 7 times more. Cast off loosely all sts.

Place marker 13 (14, 15, 16)cm down from shoulder edge to denote armhole opening. Sew in sleeves, join side and sleeve seams.

Bottom Edge

With RS facing, 4.00mm needles and D, beg at left front opening edge, pick up and k36 (39, 42, 45) sts across bottom edge of each of the 4 squares. 144 (156, 168, 180) sts. Cast off loosely in k on WS.

Place 4 (4, 5, 5) button markers along left front edge, the first one 1.5cm from neck edge (omitting Gtst edging), the last one just above join of the 2 front squares and the rem evenly in between.

BUTTON BAND

With RS facing, 3.75mm needles and D, beg at bottom edge of left front, pick up and k96 (104, 114, 122) sts to neck edge (omitting Gtst edging). Gtst 4 rows. Cast off loosely in k on WS.

BUTTONHOLE BAND

With RS facing, 3.75mm needles and D, beg at bottom edge of right front, pick up and k96 (104, 114, 122) sts to neck edge (omitting Gtst edging).

Next Row: WS – K all sts.

Next Row: (K to marker, k2tog, yo twice, skp) 4 (4, 5, 5) times, k to end. **Next Row:** K across, work buttonhole sts as follows: k1 into 1st yo, then k1 into the back of 2nd yo.

K 1 more row. Cast off loosely in k on WS.

Sew on buttons.

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Summer babies look so cute in singlets and pants. The fine 4-ply yarn is ideal for giving just the right cover for summer.

YARN

Panda Regal 4-ply 50g balls

- Singlet: 1 (1, 2)
- Pants main colour (m): 1 (1, 1)
- Contrast colour (c): 1 (1, 1)

NEEDLES AND TOOLS

- 3.25mm knitting needles
- 3.25mm set of double pointed knitting needles
- 2.75mm knitting needles
- 3 stitch holders
- Wool needle for sewing seams
- Length of hat elastic for pants

MEASUREMENTS

Months: 1, 3, 6
Underarm cm: 35, 40, 45
Actual size cm: 40, 45, 50
Length approx cm: 19, 23, 25
Pants waist cm: 35, 40, 45
Actual size cm: 42, 47, 52
Lengthapprox cm: 25, 32, 37

TENSION

28 sts by 36 rows to 10cm using stocking st with 3.25 needles

GETTING STARTED

Using a pair of 3.25mm needles, cast on 54 (60, 66) sts.

WORKING PATTERN SINGLET BACK

Work 7 rows garter st – first row is wrong side.

Row 8: Knit, inc 3 sts evenly across.

57 [63, 69] sts.

Row 9: K4, purl to last 4 sts, K4. Rep last 2 rows without increase until work measures 5cm from beg, ending with a 9th row.

Next row: Cast on 1 st this allows for seam, knit to end. 58 [64, 70] sts.

Next row: Cast on 1 st, purl to end. 59 [65, 71] sts.

Work in stocking st, beg with a knit row until work measures 10 (13, 14) cm from beg, ending with a purl row.

Shape Armholes

Cast off 4 sts at beg of next 2 rows. 51 [57, 63] sts.

Next row: Dec 1 st at each end of next row, then in every foll alt row until 43 [47, 53] sts rem. **

Work 13 (15, 19) rows, without further dec.

Shape Back Neck

Next row: K11 (12, 14), turn. Cont on these 11 (12, 14) sts for right side of neck.

Dec 1 st at neck edge in next 2 rows, then in every foll alt row 3 times. 6 (7, 9) sts.

Work 1 row.

Cast off rem sts.

Slip next 21 (23, 25) sts onto a stitch holder and leave for neckband. With right side facing, join yarn rem 11 (12, 14) sts for left side of neck and knit to end.

Dec 1 st at neck edge in next 2

rows, then in every foll alt row 3 times, 6 (7, 9) sts.
Work 1 row.
Cast off rem sts.

FRONT

Work as given for Back to **. Work 3 rows.

Shape Front Neck:

Next row: K13 (14, 16), turn. Cont on these 13 (14, 16) sts for left side of neck.

Dec 1 st at neck edge in every foll alt row until 6 (7, 9) sts rem.

Work 5 (5-7) rows.

Cast off rem sts.

Slip next 17 (19, 21) sts onto a stitch holder and leave for neckband. With right side facing, join yarn to rem 13 (14, 16) sts for right side of neck.

Dec 1 st at neck edge in every foll alt row until 6 (7, 9) sts rem.

Work 5 (5, 7) rows.

Cast off rem sts.

MAKING UP NECKBAND

Using mattress st, join shoulder seams. With right side facing and using a set of double pointed 3.25mm needles, beg at left shoulder seam and knit up 12 (14, 16) sts evenly along left side of front neck, knit across 17 (19, 21) sts from front stitch holder, dec 3 sts



evenly across, knit up 12 (14, 16) sts evenly along right side of front neck, knit up10 sts evenly along right side of back neck, knit across 21 (23, 25) sts from back stitch holder, dec 3 sts evenly across, then knit up 10 sts evenly along left side of back neck, 76 [84, 92] sts. Purl 1 round. Cast off.

Armhole Bands

With right side facing and using a pair of 3.25mm needles, knit up 53 (59, 63) sts evenly around armhole edge. Knit 1 row. Cast off. Sew side seams, leaving side splits open.

PANTS – BACK AND FRONT

Make two the same.

1st Leg

Using 3.25mm needles and M, cast on 28 (32, 35) sts.

Knit 7 rows garter st, 1st row is wrong side, inc 3 sts evenly across last row. 31 [35, 38] sts.

Work in stocking st stripes of 4 rows C and 4 rows M throughout until work measures 10 (14, 18) cm from beg, ending with a purl row. **

Leave sts on a stitch-holder.

2nd Leg

Work as given for 1st leg to **.

Crotch

Row 1: K29 (33, 36), K2tog, slip sts from stitch holder onto left hand needle, sl 1, K1, psso, knit to end. 60 [68, 74] sts.

Cont in stocking st stripes, without further dec, until work measures approx 22 (29, 34) cm from beg, ending with 3 rows C.

Next row: Purl, dec 5 sts evenly

across. 55 [63, 69] sts.

Beg Waist

Change to 2.75mm needles and M for rem.

Row 1: K2, * P1, K1, rep from * to last st, K1.

Row 2 : K1, * P1, K1, rep from * to end.

Rep last 2 rows 4 times (10 rows rib in all).

Cast off loosely in rib.

MAKING UP

Join side and leg seams. Thread hat elastic through wrong side of rib at waistline and draw up to desired measurement.

Striped baby blanket in 4 colours

YARN

- 3 x balls 50gm Biggan Design DK Merino First Cross Wool 8Ply Main colour 390 Citrine or 735 Soft Blue
- 1 x balls 50gm Biggan Design DK Merino First Cross Wool 8Ply Colour
 1 080 White or 090 Natural
- 2 x balls 50gm Biggan Design DK Merino First Cross Wool 8Ply Colour 2 925 Rose or 745 Denim
- 2 x balls 50gm Biggan Design DK Merino First Cross Wool 8Ply Colour 3 945 Candy Floss or 670 Aquamarine

NEEDLES AND TOOLS

- 4.00mm knitting needles OR
- 4.00mm circular needle 80 cm long

MEASUREMENTS

Size 80x 100cm

TENSION

22 sts by 29 rows over stocking stitch to 10 cm

GETTING STARTED

It is easier to knit the baby blanket back and forth on a circular needle, than on straight ones, as the weight of the blanket will then be resting in your lap, instead of being held up by your arms and shoulders, while you are knitting.

Moss stitch: *K1, P1, rep from * until last st, K1. Rep this row.

Please note: All pattern rows start and finish on RS.

RELIEF PATTERN FOR LETTERS

On RS work letters in PURL stitches and on WS work letters in KNIT stitches.

This will make letters stick out on RS of work and give the relief effect. The name on blanket you will have to work out on a piece of graph paper with a diamond placed at either side of name.

WORKING PATTERN STRIPED BABY BLANKET

With Mc cast on 155 sts on size 4mm straight OR 4mm circ needles and work 14 rows in moss.st.

Change to st.st, except for 11 first and

11 last sts on row, which will cont to be worked in moss.st.

Work until 4 – 6 metres of yarn

remains, so you will begin Fair Isle pattern on RS.

Work Fair Isle pattern by following chart for stripes, cont to follow chart until end of blanket.

Design notes:

- Make all colour changes on RS of work.
- Always knit first st at colour change with both colours of yarn, to then cont with new colour only. This locks in the yarn and makes it easier to fasten later on.
- On last stripe work one row less of st.st. than on first stripe of blanket.

Change to moss.st 14 rows. Cast off in moss.st.

MAKING UP

Fasten off all loose ends invisibly, by weaving them into the moss.st on WS of blanket not along the edges, as this will give a clumsy finish.

• 1, 1, 1, 2, 2 balls 100gm Shepherd Colour Play 8ply in Pink 6076

NEEDLES AND TOOLS

- 4.00mm knitting needles
- 4.00mm circular needle
- 1 stitch holder
- Wool sewing needle

MEASUREMENTS

Age: 3, 6, 9, 12, 18mths To fit chest: 40, 45, 50, 53, 55cm Finished fit: 40, 45, 50, 53, 55cm Length: 20, 23, 26, 29, 32cm

TENSION

22 sts by 30 rows over stocking st, on 4.00mm needles to 10cm.

WORKING PATTERN BACK

Using 4.00mm needles, cast on 46 (52, 56, 60, 62) sts. Work 5 rows garter st (first row is wrong side).

Working in stocking st for rem (beg with a knit row), work 28 (36, 42, 50, 56) rows.

Shape Armholes

Cast off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows. 40 (46, 50, 54, 56) sts.

Dec one st at each end of next row, then in every foll alt row until 32 (38, 42, 44, 46) sts rem.

Work 19 (21, 23, 23, 25) rows.

Shape Shoulders

Cast off 4 (5, 6, 6, 7) sts at beg of next 2 rows, then 4 (5, 6, 6, 6) sts at beg of following 2 rows.

Leave rem 16 (18, 18, 20, 20) sts on stitch-holder for neck edging.

LEFT FRONT

Using 4.00mm needles, cast on 24 (27, 29, 31, 32) sts.

Work 5 rows garter st (first row is wrong side).

Beg Pattern

Row 1: Knit.

Row 2: K3, purl to end.

Rep last 2 rows 12 (15, 17, 19, 21) times. 26 (32, 36, 40, 44) rows patt in all.

Beg Garter St Bib

Row 1: Knit.

Row 2: K5, purl to end.

Sizes 6, 9, 12 and 18 months only

Row 3: Knit.

Row 4: K6, purl to end.

Sizes 9, 12 and 18 months only

Row 5: Knit.

Row 6: K7, purl to end.

Sizes 12 and 18 months only

Row 7: Knit.

Row 8: K8, purl to end.

Row 9: Knit.

Row 10: K9, purl to end.

Size 18 months only

Row 11: Knit.

Row 12: K10, purl to end.

All sizes Shape Armhole

Row 1: Cast off 3 sts, knit to end. 21 (24, 26, 28, 29) sts.

Row 2: K6 (7, 8, 10, 11), purl to end.

Row 3: K2tog, knit to end.

Row 4: K7 (8, 9, 11, 12), purl to end.

Row 5: K2tog, knit to end.

Row 6: K8 (9, 10, 12, 12), purl to end.

Row 7: K2tog, knit to end.

Row 8: K9 (10, 11, 12, 12), purl to end.

Row 9: K2tog, knit to end.

Row 10: K10 (10, 12, 12, 12), purl to end.

Row 11: (K2tog) O (0, 0, 1, 1) times, knit to end. 17 (20, 22, 23, 24) sts.

Row 12: K10 (10, 12, 12, 12), purl to end.

Row 13: Knit.

Rep last 2 rows 2 (2, 2, 3, 3) times.

Shape Neck

Keeping garter st bib correct, cast off 4 (4, 4, 5, 5) sts at beg of next row. 13 (16, 18, 18, 19) sts. Dec one st at neck edge in next 3 rows, then in every foll alt row until 8 (10, 12, 12, 13) sts rem. Work 3 (3, 5, 5, 7) rows.

Shape Shoulder

Cast off 4 (5, 6, 6, 7) sts at beg of next row.

Work 1 row.

Cast off rem 4 (5, 6, 6, 6) sts.

RIGHT FRONT

Using 4.00mm needles, cast on 24 (27, 29, 31, 32) sts. Work 5 rows garter st (first row is

wrong side).

Beg Pattern

Row 1: Knit.

Row 2: Purl to last 3 sts, K3.

Rep last 2 rows 12 (15, 17, 19, 21) times. 26 (32, 36, 40, 44) rows patt in all.

Beg Garter St Bib

Row 1: Knit.

Row 2: Purl to last 5 sts, K5.

Sizes 6, 9, 12 and 18 months only

Row 3: Knit.

Row 4: Purl to last 6 sts, K6.

Sizes 9, 12 and 18 months only

Row 5: Knit.

Row 6: Purl to last 7 sts, K7.

Sizes 12 and 18 months only

Row 7: Knit.

Row 8: Purl to last 8 sts, K8.

Row 9: Knit.

Row 10: Purl to last 9 sts, K9.

Size 18 months only

Row 11: Knit.

Row 12: Purl to last 10 sts, K10.

All sizes – Knit 1 row.

Shape Armhole

Row 1: Cast off 3 sts, purl to last 6 (7, 8, 10, 11) sts, knit to end. 21 (24, 26, 28, 29) sts.

Row 2: Knit to last 2 sts, K2tog.

Row 3: Purl to last 7 (8, 9, 11, 12) sts, knit to end.

Row 4: Knit to last 2 sts, K2tog.

Row 5: Purl to last 8 (9, 10, 12, 12) sts, knit to end.

Row 6: Knit to last 2 sts, K2tog.

Row 7: Purl to last 9 (10, 11, 12,

12) sts, knit to end.

Row 8: Knit to last 2 sts, K2tog.

Row 9: Purl to last 10 (10, 12, 12,

12) sts, knit to end.

Row 10: Knit to last 0 (0, 0, 2, 2) sts, (K2tog) O (0, 0, 1, 1) times. 17 (20, 22, 23, 24) sts.

Row 11: Purl to last 10 (10, 12, 12, 12) sts, knit to end.

Row 12: Knit.

Row 13: Purl to last 10 (10, 12, 12, 12) sts, knit to end.

Rep last 2 rows 1 (1, 1, 2, 2) times.

Shape Neck

Keeping garter st bib correct, cast off 4 (4, 4, 5, 5) sts at beg of next row. 13 (16, 18, 18, 19) sts.

Work 1 row.

Dec one st at neck edge in next 3 rows, then in every foll alt row until 8 (10, 12, 12, 13) sts rem.

Work 4 (4, 6, 6, 8) rows.

Shape Shoulder

Cast off 4 (5, 6, 6, 7) sts at beg of next row.

Work 1 row.

Cast off rem 4 (5, 6, 6, 6) sts.

NECK EDGING AND TIES

Join shoulder seams.

Using 4.00mm circular needle, cast on 48 sts, turn, with right side of vest facing, knit up 14 (14, 15, 15, 18) sts evenly along right front neck shaping, knit across sts from back stitch-holder, knit up 14 (14, 15, 15, 18) sts evenly along left front neck shaping, turn, cast on 48 sts. 140 (142, 144, 146, 152) sts.

Knit 1 row.

Cast off loosely knitways.

ARMHOLE EDGINGS

With RS facing and using 4.00mm needles, knit up 48 (50, 52, 56, 60) sts evenly around armhole edge. Knit 1 row.

Cast off loosely knitways.



WORKING PATTERN BACK

Using 3.25mm needles, cast on 49 (57, 63, 65, 71, 77, 83) sts. **Row 1:** K2, * P1, K1, rep from

* to last st, K1.

Row 2: K1, * P1, K1, rep from * to end.

Last 2 rows form rib.
Work a further 12 (12, 12, 14, 14, 18, 18) rows rib.

Change to 4.00mm needles. Work 24 (36, 42, 46, 54, 60, 66) rows stocking st, beg with a knit row. **

Shape Armholes

Cast off 4 (4, 5, 5, 5, 6, 6) sts at beg of next 2 rows. 41 (49, 53, 55, 61, 65, 71) sts.

Dec one st at each end of next row, then in every foll alt row until 33 (39, 41, 43, 49, 53, 57) sts rem. Work 19 (23, 23, 23, 27, 29, 33) rows.

Shape Back Neck

Next Row: K8 (10, 11, 12, 14, 15, 17), cast off next 17 (19, 19, 19, 21, 23, 23) sts, knit to end.

Cont on these 8 (10, 11, 12, 14, 15, 17) sts for left side of neck.

*** Dec one st at neck edge in every row until 3 (5, 6, 7, 9, 10, 12) sts rem.

Work 1 row.

Shape Shoulder

Sizes 2, 4, 6 and 8 years only Cast off (4, 5, 5, 6) sts at beg of next row. Work 1 row.

Cast off rem 3 (5, 6, 3, 4, 5, 6) sts. ***

With wrong side facing, join yarn to rem sts for right side of neck.
Work from *** to ***, omitting row worked before shoulder.

FRONT

Work as for Back to **.

Shape Armholes and V Neck Next Row: Cast off 4 (4, 5, 5, 5, 6, 6) sts, knit to end. 45 (53, 58, 60, 66, 71, 77) sts. **Next Row:** Cast off 4 (4, 5, 5, 5, 6, 6) sts, P20 (24, 26, 27, 30, 32, 35) incl st already on right-hand needle after cast off, turn.

Cont on these 20 (24, 26, 27, 30, 32, 35) sts for right side of neck.

*** Dec one st at each end of next row, then in every foll alt row until 12 (14, 14, 15, 18, 20, 21) sts rem.

Dec one st at neck edge only in every foll alt row 7 (5, 3, 3, 3, 4, 0) times, then in every foll 4th row 2 (4, 5, 5, 6, 6, 9) times. 3 (5, 6, 7, 9, 10, 12) sts.

Work 4 rows.

Shape Shoulder

Sizes 2, 4, 6 and 8 years only
Cast off (4, 5, 5, 6) sts at beg of next row. Work 1 row.

All sizes

Cast off rem 3 (5, 6, 3, 4, 5, 6) sts. ***

Slip centre st onto a safety pin or contrasting thread and leave for neckband.

With wrong side facing, join yarn to rem 20 (24, 26, 27, 30, 32, 35) sts for left side of neck and purl to end. Rep from *** to *** working 3 rows before shoulder.

NECKBAND

evenly along right side of front neck to shoulder seam, knit up 5 sts evenly along right side of back neck, knit up 17 (21, 21, 21, 23, 23, 23) sts across back cast-off, then knit up 5 sts evenly along left side of back neck. 96 (112, 116, 116, 126, 130, 142) sts.

Row 1: * K1, P1, rep from * to end. Row 2: Rib to within 2 sts of centre st, ybk, sl 1, K1, psso, K1 (centre st), K2tog, rib to end.

Row 3: Rib to within 2 sts of centre st, K2tog, P1, K2tog tbl, rib to end. Rep 2nd and 3rd rows 3 (3, 3, 4, 4, 4, 4) times. 80 (96, 100, 96, 106, 110, 122) sts. Cast off loosely in rib.

ARMHOLE BANDS

Join left shoulder and neckband seam. With RS facing and using 3.25mm needles, knit up 51 (59, 63, 63, 69, 73, 81) sts evenly along armhole edge.

Work 9 (9, 9, 11, 11, 11, 11) rows rib as for Back, beg with a 2nd row. Cast off loosely in rib.

Do not press. Join side and armhole band seams.

Next Row: RS - K1, k2tog, k11, k2tog, k1, skp, k11, skp, k1. 29 sts. K 1 row straight. Cast off loosely. Join back and sole. Work 2nd bootie to match.

Shape Neck

Using 3.25mm needles, cast on 29 (29, 29, 33, 33) sts. Work 8 (8, 10, 10, 10) rows moss st as for Back, inc 0 (2, 2, 0, 0) sts evenly across last row. 29 (31, 31, 33, 33) sts.

Change to 4.00mm needles. Work 4 rows stocking st.

Row 5: K2, M1, knit to last 2 sts, M1, K2. 31 (33, 33, 35, 35) sts. Cont in stocking st for rem, inc one st (as before) at each end of every foll 4th (6th, 6th, 8th, 8th) row until there are 37 (39, 41, 43, 45) sts. Cont without further shaping until Sleeve measures 11 (13, 16, 19, 21) cm from beg, ending with a purl row.

Shape Top

Cast off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows. 33 (35, 37, 39, 41) sts. Dec one st at each end of next row, then in every foll alt row until 25 sts rem, then in every row until 15 sts rem. Cast off rem sts.

NECKBAND

Join shoulder seams.

Note: We suggest using a set of double-pointed needles for ease of working the neckband. Work backwards and forwards in rows.

With RS facing and using set of 3.25mm double-pointed needles, knit up 11 (12, 12, 13, 13) sts evenly along right side of front neck to shoulder seam, knit up 3 sts evenly along right back neck, knit across sts from back stitch-holder, knit up 3 sts evenly along left back neck to shoulder seam, then knit up 11 (12, 12, 13, 13) sts evenly along left side of front neck. 45 (49, 49, 53, 53) sts. Work 9 rows moss st as for Back. Cast off loosely in moss st.

LEFT FRONT BAND

With right side facing and using 3.25mm needles, knit up 13 (13, 13, 17, 17) sts evenly along side edge of neckband and left side of front opening.

Complete as for neckband.

RIGHT FRONT BAND

With right side facing and using 3.25mm needles, knit up 13 (13, 13, 17, 17) sts evenly along right side of front opening and side edge of neckband.

Complete as for neckband.

MAKING UP

With a slightly damp cloth and warm iron, press lightly on wrong side, avoiding bands. Join side and sleeve seams. Sew in sleeves. Sew end of right front band to 5 sts cast off at centre front. Slip-stitch end of left front band in position underneath.

Round Armhole: K17 (20, 23, 26) sts, cast off 26 (28, 31, 34) sts, k until there are 138 (160, 180, 200) sts on needle after first armhole opening, cast off 26 (28, 31, 34) sts, k to end.

Round 6 dec: *K4 (5, 6, 7) sts, k2tog; rep from * to end of round. 160 (192, 224, 256) sts. Stst 6 (6, 7, 7) rounds.

Round 7 dec: *K3 (4, 5, 6) sts, k2tog; rep from * to end of round. 128 (160, 192, 224) sts. Stst 4 (4, 6, 6) rounds.

Round 8 dec: *K2 (3, 4, 5) sts, k2tog; rep from * to end of round. 96 (128, 160, 192) sts.

Stst 4 (4, 6, 6) rounds.

Round 9 dec: *K1 (2, 3, 4) sts, k2tog; rep from * to end of round. 64 (96, 128, 160) sts. Stst 4 (4, 5, 6) rounds.

Sizes 4, 6, 8 years only

Round 10 dec: *K1 (2, 3) sts, k2tog; rep from * to end of round. 64 (96, 128) sts.

Stst 4 (5, 5) rounds.

Round 11 dec: *K1 (2) sts, k2tog; rep from * to end of round. 64 (96) sts. Stst 5 rounds.

Sizes 8 years only

Round 12 dec: *K1 sts, k2tog; rep from * to end of round. 64 sts. Stst 5 rounds.

Next Round: K2tog across round. 32 sts.

Stst 4 rounds.

Row 6: (P2tog) 5 times. 5 sts.

Break yarn, leaving longer end, thread end through rem sts and pull together firmly, but ensure not to break the yarn; thread end through couple more times; join sides.

Have the child put on the garment for best fastener placement choice and place marker.

Sew on fastener.

Sew button to centre of flower, then sew flower in place (above fastener).

Row 33: Inc in first st, knit to last 2 sts, K2tog. 68 sts.

Row 34: P2tog, purl to end. 67 sts. Row 35: Knit to last 2 sts, K2tog. 66 sts.

Rep 34th and 35th rows 3 times. 60 sts.

Row 42: Cast off 3 sts, purl to end. 57 sts.

Row 43: Knit to last 2 sts, K2tog. 56 sts.

Rep 42nd and 43rd rows 4 times. 40 sts.

Row 25: Inc in first st, purl to end. 68 sts.

Work 3 rows.

Row 29: Inc in first st, purl to end. 69 sts.

Knit 1 row.

Row 31: Purl to last 2 sts, P2tog. 68 sts.

Knit 1 row.

Row 33: Inc in first st, purl to last 2 sts, P2tog. 68 sts.

Row 34: K2tog, knit to end. 67 sts. Row 35: Purl to last 2 sts, P2tog.

66 sts.

Rep 34 and 35 rows 3 times. 60 sts.

Row 42: Cast off 3 sts, knit to end. 57 sts.

Row 43: Purl to last 2 sts, P2tog. 56 sts.

Rep 42nd and 43rd rows 4 times. 40 sts.

Work 53 rows.

Beg Top

Change to C for rem.

Work in stocking st for 9cm, beg with a purl row.

Cast off very loosely.

Loop (i-cord)

Using two 4.00mm double-pointed needles and M, cast on 5 sts.

Row 1: Knit, do not turn.

Slip sts to other end of needle. Pull yarn firmly across back of work and rep 1st

row. Cont working each row in the same direction until cord measures 15cm. Break off yarn and thread end through sts, draw up tightly and fasten off securely.



Row 2, 4 and 6: Purl to last 12 sts, k2, p9, kl.

Row 8: Purl to last 12 sts, k2, p9, k1. Rows 1 to 8 sets cable panel and st-st,

Keeping continuity of patt as set (throughout) work 6 (14, 21, 8, 14, 45) rows dec 1 st at side edge in 3rd (3rd, lst, 3rd, 3rd, 3rd) and every foil 0 (4th, 4th, 6th, 6th, 6th) row. 30 (32, 33, 42, 44, 41) sts.

For 1st, 2nd, 4th and 5th sizes only Work 5 (3, 21, 21) rows dec 1 st at side edge in next and every foil 2nd

side edge in next and every foil 2nd (2nd, 4th, 4th) row. 27 (30, 36, 38) sts.

For all 6 sizes

Cont without shaping until right front measures 11 (13, 15, 18, 20, 23)cm, ending with a RS row.

Shape Raglan

Next Row: Cast off 4 (4, 4, 5, 5, 5) sts, patt to end. 23 (26, 29, 31, 33, 36) sts.

Work 2 rows dec 1 st at raglan edge in every row. (29, 34) sts.

Shape Neck

Using 3.25mm needles and thumb method, cast on 46 (46, 50, 50, 54, 58) sts, starting with 2nd row of 2x2 rib work 17 (17, 19, 19, 23, 23) rows.

Next Row: P2 (2, 6, 4, 1, 3), p2tog, (p2 (2, 1, 2, 3, 3), p2tog) 10 (10, 12, 10, 10, 10) times, p2 (2, 6, 4, 1, 3). 35(35, 37, 39, 43, 47) sts.

Change to 4mm needles and working in st-st (throughout) inc 1 st at each end of 7th and every fall 24th (6th, 6th, 8th, 10th, 12th) row to 39 (41, 41, 53, 57, 61) sts.

For 2nd and 3rd sizes only

Inc 1 st at each end of every fall (8th, 8th) row to (45, 49) sts.

For all 6 sizes

Cont without shaping until sleeve measures 14 (16, 19, 23, 28, 32) cm, from top of rib, or length required, ending with a WS row.

Shape Raglan

Cast off 4 (4, 4, 5, 5, 5) sts at beg of next 2 rows. 31 (37, 41, 43, 47, 51) sts.

For 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th sizes only Work 8 (4, 4, 4) rows dec 1 st at each end of next and foil 4th (0, 0, 0) row. 27 (35, 39, 41) sts.

For all 6 sizes

Work 16 (24, 26, 28, 34, 38) rows dec 1 st at each end of next and every foil alt row. 11 (11, 13, 13, 13, 13) sts. Cast off rem 11 (11, 13, 13, 13, 13, 13) sts.

RIGHT FRONT BORDER

Join raglan seams. With RS facing, using 3.25mm needles pick up and knit 6 sts evenly along rib and 57 (65, 73, 81, 85, 93) sts evenly along front edge. 63 (71, 79, 87, 91, 99) sts. **Row 1:** K 1, * p2, k2, rep from * to

last 2 sts, p2. **Row 2:** K2, * p2, k2, rep from * to

last st. k 1. Rows 1 and 2 set rib.

Work 1 row more in rib.

Row 4: Rib to last 7 sts, cast off 2 sts, rib 4.

Row 5: Rib 5, cast on 2 sts, rib to end. Work 3 rows more in rib. Cast off in rib.

LEFT FRONT BORDER

With RS facing, using 3.25mm needles, pick up and knit 57 (65, 73, 81, 85, 93) sts evenly along front edge and 6 sts evenly along rib. 63 (71, 79, 87, 91, 99) sts.

Row 1: * P2, k2, rep from * to last 3 sts, p2, k1.

Row 2: P1, k2, * p2, k2, rep from * to end.

Rows 1 and 2 set rib. Work 6 rows more in rib. Cast off in rib.

HOOD

Using 4.00mm needles cast on 26 (26, 26, 28, 28, 30) sts, with RS facing, using same needles and yarn pick up and knit 21 (23, 27, 27, 31, 31) sts from 17 (19, 23, 23, 27, 27) cast off sts at back of neck and cast on 26(26, 26, 28, 28, 30) sts. 73 (75, 79, 83, 87, 91) sts.

Next Row: Purl.

Working in st-st (throughout) cont until hood measures 15 (17, 18, 19, 20, 21)cm, ending with a WS row.

Shape Top

Next Row: Cast off 24 (25, 26, 27, 29, 30) sts, k24 (24, 26, 28, 28, 30), cast off rem 24 (25, 26, 27, 29, 30) sts. 25(25, 27, 29, 29, 31) sts. With WS facing, rejoin yarn to rem 25 (25, 27, 29, 29, 31) sts and purl to end.

Cont without shaping until hood measures 11 (11, 12, 13, 13, 14)cm, from cast off sts, ending with a WS row. Cast off.

Join side edges of hood to 24 (25, 26, 27, 29, 30) cast off sts.

HOOD BORDER

With RS facing, using 3.25mm needles pick up and knit 47 (51, 54, 56, 59, 62) sts evenly along right side of hood, 32 (32, 32, 34, 36, 38) sts from 25 (25, 27, 29, 29, 31) cast off sts at top of hood and 47 (51, 54, 56, 59, 62) sts evenly along left side of hood. 126 (134, 140, 146, 154, 162) sts.

Starting with 1st row of 2x2 rib work for 6 (6, 7, 7, 8, 8)cm, ending with a WS row. Cast off in rib.

MAKING UP

Join side seams. Join sleeve seams reversing sewing for 4 (4, 5, 5, 6, 6) cm, for turn back.

Fold hood border back onto RS for 4 (4, 5, 5, 6, 6) cm, placing fold halfway across front borders sew cast on edge of hood evenly in position at neck edge and across top of sleeves. Sew on button. Pin out garment to the measurement given. Cover with damp cloths and leave until dry. See ball band for washing and further care instructions.

Work as given for Back of Jacket with Hood.

RIGHT FRONT

Work as given for Right Front of Jacket with Hood.

LEFT FRONT

Work as given for Left Front of Jacket with Hood.

SLEEVES (BOTH ALIKE)

Work as given for Sleeves of Jacket with Hood.

RIGHT FRONT BORDER

Work as given for Right Front Border of Jacket with Hood.

LEFT FRONT BORDER

Work as given for Left Front Border of Jacket with Hood.

COLLAR

Join raglan seams. With RS facing, using 3.25mm needles, starting halfway across Right Front Border pick up and knit 14 (14, 17, 17, 17, 17) sts evenly along right side of neck, 11 (11, 13, 13, 13, 13) sts from top of right sleeve, 21 (23, 27, 27, 31, 31) sts from 17 (19, 23, 23, 27, 27) cast off sts at back of neck, 11 (11, 13, 13, 13, 13) sts from top of left sleeve and 14(14, 17, 17, 17, 17) sts evenly along left side of neck, ending halfway across border. 71 (73, 87, 87, 91, 91) sts.

Row 1: (K2, p2) 3 (4, 5, 5, 4, 4) times, k2, (p1, k2) 15 (13, 15, 15, 19, 19) times, (p2, k2) 3 (4, 5, 5, 4, 4) times.

Row 2: (P2, k2) 3 (4, 5, 5, 4, 4) times, (p2, k1) 15 (13, 15, 15, 19, 19) times, p2, (k2, p2) 3 (4, 5, 5, 4, 4) times.

Rep 1st and 2nd rows once more then 1st row once.

Row 6: (P2, k2) 3 (4, 5, 5, 4, 4) times, (p2, inc in next st) 15 (13, 15, 15, 19, 19) times, p2, (k2, p2) 3 (4, 5, 5, 4, 4) times. 86 (86, 102, 102, 110, 110) sts.

Starting with 1st row of 2x2 rib cant until collar measures 8 (8, 9, 9, 10, 10) cm, ending with a RS row. **Next Row:** (P2, k2) 7 (7, 8, 8, 9, 9) times, p2, (inc in next st, k l, p2) 7 (7, 9, 9, 9, 9) times, (k2, p2) 7 (7, 8, 8, 9, 9) times. 93 (93, 111, 111, 119, 119) sts.

Cast off in patt.

MAKING UP

Join side seams.

Join sleeve seams reversing sewing for 4 (4, 5, 5, 6, 6) cm, for turn back.

Sew on button. Pin out garment to the measurement given. Cover with damp cloths and leave until dry. See ball band for washing and further care instructions.

Round 1: 3ch, 11tr in ring, sl st in 3rd ch at beg, sl st in sp before next tr. 12tr.

Round 2: 3ch, 1tr in same sp as sl st, 2tr in sp before each tr to end, sl st in 3rd ch at beg, sl st in space before next tr. 24tr.

Round 3: 3ch, 1tr in same sp as sl st, 1tr in sp before next tr, *2tr in sp before next tr, 1tr in sp before next tr, rep from * to end, sl st in 3rd ch at beg, sl st in sp before next tr. 36tr.

Round 4: 3ch, 1tr in same sp as

sl st, 1tr in sp before each of next 2tr, *2tr in sp before next tr, 1tr in sp before each of next 2tr, rep from * to end, change to white, sl st in 3rd ch at beg. 48tr.

Round 5: 6ch, (1dtr, 1tr) in same st as sl st, * miss 1tr, 1tr in next tr, 1htr in each of next 2tr, 1dc in each of next 3tr, 1htr in each of next 2tr, 1tr in ext tr, miss 1tr ** (1tr, 1dtr, 2ch, 1dtr, 1tr) in next tr * rep from * to * twice, then rep from * to ** once, 1tr in same st as sl st at end of last round, sl st in 4th ch at beg.

Round 6: 3ch, * (1tr, 2ch, 1tr) in corner 2ch sp, 1tr in each st to next corner 2ch sp, rep from * 3 times, (1tr, 2ch, 1tr) in 2ch sp, 1tr in each st to end, sl st in 3rd ch at beg.

Round 7: 3ch, 1tr in next tr, * (1tr, 2ch, 1tr) in corner 2ch sp, 1tr in each tr to next corner 2ch sp, rep from * twice, (1tr, 2ch, 1tr) in 2ch

sp, 1tr in each tr to end, sl st in 3rd ch at beg. Fasten off.

MAKING UP


Do not press. Using a flat seam and following assembly picture join motifs.

Edging

With RS facing using 4.50mm hook and white, work 1 round of tr around edges of rug, inc or dec if necessary to keep work flat and working (1tr, 2ch, 1tr) in each corner as before. Rep last round 3 more times. Work one row Crab Stitch if desired. Fasten off.



WORKING PATTERN BLANKET

Strip 1

Using 5.50mm needles and C1, cast on 19 sts.

** Work 66 rows stocking st, tying a coloured thread at each end of 22nd and 44th rows to assist with make up. **

Work 22 rows each of C4 and C5.
Using C2, rep from ** to ** once.
Work 22 rows each of C6, C1 and C4.
242 rows in all.
Cast off loosely.

Strips 2 to 11

Using 5.50mm needles and appropriate colour following diagram cast on 19 sts.

Work in stocking st blocks of 22, 44 or 66 rows (tying coloured threads as before to assist with aligning squares when making up).

Cast off loosely.

EDGING

Join strips together matching coloured threads to ends of blocks. With right side facing, using 5.50mm circular needle and M, knit up 177 sts evenly along one edge of Blanket.

Work 39 rows garter st, at same time inc one st at each end of every foll alt row. 215 sts.

Cast off loosely knitways. Rep edging along rem 3 sides of Blanket.

MAKING UP

Join edging at corners. With a slightly damp cloth and warm iron, press seams lightly. Sew in ends.

TENSION

22 sts and 30 rows to 10cm over stocking st, using 4.00mm needles.

WORKING PATTERN BACK

Using 4.00mm needles and C2, cast on 45 (51, 58, 64) sts.

Row 1: WS Knit. Row 2: Purl.

Row 3: Knit, inc 4 (4, 5, 5) sts evenly across. 49 (55, 63, 69) sts, completing purl fabric band.

Beg Stripe Patt:

Work in stocking st stripes of 2 rows C1, 2 rows C2 and 2 rows C3.
Last 6 rows form stripe patt.
Work a further 28 (34, 40, 46) rows stripe patt, ending with 2 rows C2. 34 (40, 46, 52) rows stripe patt in all.

Shape Raglan Armholes:

Keeping stripe patt correct, cast off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows. 45 (51, 59, 65) sts. **

Dec one st at each end of next row, then in every foll 4th row until 31 (37, 51, 57) sts rem, then in every foll alt row until 29 (31, 31, 33) sts rem. Work 1 row. Leave rem sts on a stitch, holder for Neckband.

FRONT

Work as for Back to **.

Dec one st at each end of next row, then in every foll 4th row until 37 (41, 51, 57) sts rem, sizes 6 and 9 months only, then in every foll alt row until (43, 47) sts rem.

All sizes: 37 (41, 43, 47) sts. Work 3 (3, 1, 1) row/s stripe patt.

Shape neck:

Next row: K2tog, patt 10 (11, 12, 14), turn.

*** Cont on these 11 (12, 13, 15) sts. Keeping stripe patt correct, dec one st at raglan edge in every foll 4th (4th, alt, alt) row 2 (1, 5, 6) time/s, sizes 0 and 3 months only, then in every foll alt row 1 (3) time/s, AT SAME TIME dec one st at neck edge in every row 4 times, then in every foll alt row 2 (2, 2, 3) times. 2 sts.

Next row: P2, turn, K2tog.

Fasten off. ***

Slip next 13 (15, 15, 15) sts onto stitch, holder and leave for Neckband. Join appropriate colour to rem sts, patt to last 2 sts, K2tog.

Rep from *** to ***.

SLEEVES

Using 4.00mm needles and C3, cast on 27 (29, 29, 31) sts.

Row 1: WS Knit. Row 2: Purl.

Row 3: Knit, thus completing purl fabric band.

Beg Stripe Patt:

Commencing with 2 rows C3 (C3, C1, C3), work in stripe patt as for Back, AT SAME TIME inc one st at each end of foll 3rd row, then in every foll 4th

(6th, 4th, 6th) row until there are 33 (37, 33, 39) sts, then in every foll 6th (8th, 6th, 8th) row until there are 37 (39, 43, 45) sts.

Work a further 7 (7, 9, 9) rows stripe patt without shaping, thus ending with 2 rows C2.

Shape raglan:

Keeping stripe patt correct, cast off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows. 33 (35, 39, 41) sts.

Dec one st each end of next row, sizes 3, 6 and 9 months only, then in every foll 4th row (1, 1, 2) time/s.

All sizes: 31 (31, 35, 35) sts. Dec one st at each end of every foll alt row until 5 (5, 7, 7) sts rem. Work 1 row.

Leave rem sts on a stitch, holder.

NECKBAND

Join raglan seams, matching stripes and leaving left back raglan seam open for 4cm at top, noting that tops of sleeves form part of neckline.

With right side facing, using 4.00mm needles and C3, work across left sleeve stitch, holder as folls, K3 (3, 5, 5), K2tog; knit up 10 (10, 10, 12) sts evenly along left side of neck, work across sts from front stitch, holder as folls, (K2, K2tog) 3 times, K1 (3, 3, 3); knit up 10 (10, 10, 12) sts evenly along right side of neck, work across right sleeve stitch, holder as folls, K2tog, K1 (1, 3, 3), sl 1, K1, psso; then work across back stitch, holder as folls, (K2tog, K3) 5 (6, 6, 6) times, K4 (1, 1, 3). 60 (63, 67, 73) sts.

Row 1: Knit. Row 2: Purl. Row 3: Knit.

Cast off loosely purlways.

LEFT BACK OPENING EDGING

With right side facing, using 4.00mm needles and C2, knit up 13 sts evenly along side edge of neckband and left back raglan edge, one st at base of opening and 13 sts evenly along left sleeve raglan edge and side edge of neckband. 27 sts.

Row 1: K2, yfwd, K2tog, K4, yfwd, K2tog, knit to end. 2 buttonholes. Cast off knitways.

BUTTONS (MAKE 2)

Using 4.00mm needles and C1, cast on one st.

Row 1: (K1, P1, K1, P1) all into st. 4 sts.

Row 2: Purl. Row 3: Knit. Row 4: Purl.

Row 5: Sl 2, K2tog, p2sso. 1 st. Fasten off, leaving a long length of yarn to sew button. Form into a ball shape and use end to sew to back opening edging.

MAKING UP

Join side and sleeve seams, matching stripes. Sew on buttons.

Row 2: P2, *k2, p2; rep from * to end.

Rib 1 more row with A.

Break A and join D. Rib 4 rows in D. Break D and join C. Rib 4 rows in C.

Break C and join A. Rib 3 rows in A and dec 1 st at centre of last row. 65 (73, 81, 89) sts.

Change to 3.25mm needles and MC.***

Beg with a RS row, Stst until piece meas 15 (16.5, 18, 20.5)cm from beg, end with a WS row.

Shape Raglan

Cast off 3 sts at beg next 2 rows.

Next Row: RS - K1, k2tog, k to last 3 sts, skp, k1.

Work 3 (3, 3, 1) row(s) even.

Rep last 4 (4, 4, 2) rows 2 (2, 1, 0)

times more.

Next Row: RS - K1, k2tog, knit to last 3 sts, skp, k1.

Work 1 row even.

Rep last 2 rows to 27 (31, 33, 35)

sts.

Leave sts on holder.

FRONT

Work from ** to *** as for Back. Beg with a RS row, Stst 6 (8, 8, 10) rows, end with a WS row.

Next Row: RS – K7 (11, 15, 19), work row 1 of Chart, k to end. **Next Row:** WS – P7 (11, 15, 19), work row 2 of Chart, p to end. Cont as established, working appropriate row of Chart to end of chart, then cont in MC and AT THE SAME TIME, when piece meas 15 (16.5, 18, 20.5) cm from beg, shape raglan as follows:

Cast off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows. Next Row: RS) - K1, k2tog, k to last 3 sts, skp, k1.

Work 3 (3, 3, 1) row(s) even. Rep last 4 (4, 4, 2) rows 2 (2, 1, 0) times more.

Next Row: RS - K1, k2tog, knit to last 3 sts, skp, k1.

Work 1 row even.

Rep last 2 rows to 51 (59, 63, 67) sts, end with a WS row.

Shape Neck

Next Row: RS – K1, k2tog, k22 (26, 28, 30), turn, on these sts only. Work 1 row.

Dec 1 st at each end of every RS row to 2 sts, end with a WS row.

Next Row: RS - K2tog.

Fasten off.

With RS facing, return to sts on hold, rejoin yarn, k the next st and place on holder and work 2nd half to match, reversing shaping.

SLEEVES

With 2.75mm needles and A, cast on 38 (42, 42, 46) sts.


Row 1: RS - K2, *p2, k2; rep from * to end.

Row 2: P2, *k2, p2; rep from * to end.

Rib 1 more row in A.

Break A and join D. Rib 4 rows in D. Break D and join C. Rib 4 rows in C. Break C and join A. Rib 3 rows in A and inc 2 sts evenly across last row. 40 (44, 44, 48) sts.

Change to 3.25mm needles and MC. Beg with a RS row, Stst and inc 1 st each end of 5th and every foll 8th (6th,



6th, 6th) row to 54 (58, 62, 64) sts. Work even until sleeve meas 15 (16.5, 20.5, 24)cm from beg, end with a WS row.

Shape Raglan

Cast off 3 sts at beg next 2 rows. Next Row: RS - K1, k2tog, k to last 3 sts, skp, k1.

Work 1 row even. Rep last 2 rows to 10 sts. Leave sts on holder.

MAKING UP

Join raglan seams, leaving right back seam open.

NECKBAND

With RS facing, 2.75mm needles and A, k the 27 (31, 33, 35) back neck holder sts inc (inc, dec, inc) 1 st at centre, k the 10 left sleeve holder sts, pick up and k22 (22, 26, 30) sts down left front neck, place marker, k the 1 front neck holder st, place marker, pick up and k22 (22, 26, 30) sts up right front neck, k the 10 right sleeve holder sts. 93 (97, 105, 117) sts. **Row 1:** WS - *K2, p2; rep from * to marker, p1, *p2, k2; rep from * to end of row.

Row 2: Rib to 2 sts before marker, skp, slip marker, k1, slip marker, k2tog, rib to end of row.

Row 3: Rib to marker, p1, rib to end of row. Break A and join D. Rep last 2 rows twice more using D. Cast off in rib.

Join right back raglan, leaving an opening 9cm long from top of neckband.

With RS facing, 2.75mm crochet hook and A, work 1 row double crochet evenly along raglan opening, working chain 4 buttonloop on back 6.5cm from top and again after 2.5cm. Fasten off.

Sew buttons opposite buttonloops on right sleeve. Join side and sleeve seams.

Embroidery: With D and running stitch, embroider mouth on frog, using photo as guide.

With A and running stitch, outline frog, using photo as guide.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATION

Dec = draw up an lp in each of next 2 sts, yoh and draw through all 3 lps on hook.

TENSION

Correct tension is not essential for this toy.

GETTING STARTED

Note – Toy is worked on a smaller hook and at a firmer tension than usually recommended for this yarn.

We recommend parental supervision for children under 3 years as this toy has small parts which may present a choking hazard.

WORKING PATTERN BODY (BEG AT NOSE)

Using 3.50mm hook and C1, make 2ch.

Round 1: Miss 1ch, 6dc in 2nd ch from hook, do not turn.

Note – As rounds are not completed with a sl st but worked in a spiral shape, mark end of rounds with a contrasting thread or safety pin.

Round 2: (Do not beg with a ch), (2dc in next dc) 6 times, do not join. 12dc.

Round 3: (2dc in next dc, 1dc in next dc) 6 times. 18dc.

Note – When changing colour, use new colour to work final lp of last st in old colour.

Change to M for rem.

Round 4: (2dc in next dc, 1dc in each of next 2dc) 6 times. 24dc.
Round 5: (2dc in next dc, 1dc in each of next 3dc) 6 times. 30dc.
Round 6: (2dc in next dc, 1dc in each of next 4dc) 6 times. 36dc.

Round 8: (2dc in next dc, 1dc in each of next 5dc) 6 times. 42dc. Work 1 round.

Round 10: (2dc in next dc, 1dc in each of next 6dc) 6 times. 48dc. Work 2 rounds.

Round 13: (2dc in next dc, 1dc in each of next 7dc) 6 times. 54dc. Work 4 rounds.

Round 18: (Dec, 1dc in each of next 7dc) 6 times. 48 sts.

Work 2 rounds.

Work 1 round.

Round 21: (Dec, 1dc in each of next 6dc) 6 times. 42 sts.
Work 1 round.

Round 23: (Dec, 1dc in each of next 5dc) 6 times. 36 sts.

Work 1 round.

Round 25: (Dec, 1dc in each of next 4dc) 6 times. 30 sts.

Round 26: (Dec, 1dc in each of next 3dc) 6 times. 24 sts.

Stuff body with polyester fibre filling, placing bell in centre (if desired).

Round 27: (Dec, 1dc in each of next 2dc) 6 times. 18 sts.

Round 28: (Dec, 1dc in next dc) 6 times. 12 sts.

Round 29: (Dec) 6 times. 6 sts. Fasten off.

Note – Add extra stuffing before final closure, if necessary.

Thread end through rem sts, draw up tightly and stitch to secure.

ARMS (MAKE 2)

Using 3.50mm hook and C1, make 2ch.

Work rounds 1 and 2 as for Body. 12dc.

Change to M.

Round 3: 1dc in each of next 12dc. Rep last round 4 times. Fasten off.

LEGS (MAKE 2)

Using 3.50mm hook and C1, make 2ch.

Work rounds 1 to 3 incl as for Body. 18dc.

Change to M.

of next 17dc. 24dc.

Round 4: 1dc in each of next 18dc.
Round 5: 2dc in each of first 4dc,
1dc in each of next 14dc. 22dc.
Round 6: 1dc in each of first 3dc,
2dc in each of next 2dc, 1dc in each

Round 7: (Dec) 5 times, 1dc in each of next 14dc. 19 sts.

Round 8: Dec, 1dc in next st, Dec, 1dc in each of next 14 sts to end. 17 sts.

Round 9: 1 dc in each of next 6 sts, 1htr in each of next 8 sts, 1dc in each of next 3 sts.

Rep last round once.

Fasten off.

TAIL

Using 3.50mm hook and M, make 2ch. Work rounds 1 and 2 as for Body. 12dc.

Round 3: 1dc in each of next 12dc. Round 4: (2dc in next dc, 1dc in next dc) 6 times. 18dc.

Work 2 rounds.

Round 7: (Dec, 1dc in next st) 6 times. 12 sts.

Stuff tail with polyester fibre filling.

Round 8: (Dec) 6 times. 6 sts. Fasten off.

Thread end through rem sts, draw up tightly and stitch to secure.

INNER EARS (MAKE 2)

Using 3.50mm hook and C2, make 4ch.

Row 1: Miss 1ch, 1dc in each ch to end. 3dc.

Row 2: 1ch, 1dc in each dc to end. Work 1 row.

Row 4: 1ch, 1dc in first dc, 2dc in next dc, 1dc in last dc. 4dc. Work 3 rows.

Row 8: 1ch, 1dc in first dc, 2dc in each of next 2dc, 1dc in last dc. 6dc. Work 5 rows.

Row 14: 1ch, 1dc in first dc, 2dc in next dc, 1dc in each of next 2dc, 2dc in next dc, 1dc in last dc. 8dc. Work 7 rows.

Row 22: Sl st in each of first 2dc, 1dc in each of next 4dc, sl st in each of last 2dc.

Fasten off.

OUTER EARS (MAKE 2)

Using 3.50mm hook and M, make 8ch and join with a sl st in first ch, taking care not to twist ch.

Round 1: 1ch, 1dc in same st as sl st, 1dc in each ch to end, (work in spiral, do not join with sl st). 8dc. Work 1 round.

Round 3: 2dc in first dc, 1dc in each of next 7dc. 9dc.

Work 1 round.

Round 5: 2dc in first dc, 1dc in each of next 8dc. 10dc.

Work 1 round, turn.

Rem of Outer Ears is worked in rows, not rounds.

Row 1: 1ch, 1dc in each of next 8dc, turn.

Rep last row once.

Row 3: 1ch, 1dc in first dc, 2dc in next dc, 1dc in each of next 4dc, 2dc in next dc, 1dc in last dc. 10dc. Work 5 rows.

Row 9: 1ch, 1dc in first dc, 2dc in next dc, 1dc in each of next 6dc, 2dc in next dc, 1dc in last dc. 12dc. Work 5 rows.

Row 15: 1ch, 1dc in first dc, 2dc in next dc, 1dc in each of nex t 8dc, 2dc in next dc, 1dc in last dc. 14dc. Work 2 rows.



Row 18: 1ch, 1dc in first dc, (Dec, 1dc in each of next 3dc) twice, Dec, 1dc in last dc. 11 sts.

Work 1 row.

Row 20: 1ch, 1dc in first dc, Dec, 1dc in each of next 5 sts, Dec, 1dc in last dc. 9 sts.

Row 21: Sl st in each of first 2 sts, 1dc in next st, 1htr in next st, 1tr in

next st, 1htr in next st, 1dc in next st, sl st in each of last 2 sts. Fasten off.

MAKING UP

Sew inner ears to inside of outer ears with lower ends together, then sew securely to top of head. Stuff arms and legs and sew securely in position as pictured. Using C2 and satin stitch, embroider nose. Using Black and satin stitch, embroider eyes. Attach tail as pictured.

TENSION

As for Tekapo 8ply DK

WORKING PATTERN

Pass 1 - Starting Triangles
Cast on 100 stitches.
Knit a swatch of ten blocks x 10 stitches wide.

To begin:

Purl 2, turn

Knit 2, turn

P3, turn

K3, turn

Continue this way, working one more stitch each time until you have purled 10 stitches. Do not turn.

Looking at knitting – a triangle should have been made.

Make nine more triangles in exactly the same way, ignoring the first one completely.

Design note: the second and third triangles have their tips attached to the preceding stitches. Don't worry; it's sorted on the next pass.

Pass 2 - Side Triangles and Blocks This pass is a little different. In order to have straight edges make half triangles each end. Attach second colour.

K2, turn

P2, turn

Kfb, S1 K1 psso, turn.

P3, turn

Kfb, K1, S1, K1 psso turn

P4, turn

Kfb, K2, S1, K1 psso turn

P5, turn

Continue until you have used all 10 stitches of the triangle below. After the (Kfb, K8, S1, K1 psso) row, omit turn. This will make first side triangle and there will be one of these half triangles at the beginning and the end of every other row.

Work should look like Photo 1.

Pick up 10 stitches where shown to continue making triangles. On **Photo 2**. Turn and P10, turn

K9, S1, K1 psso turn and purl back Continue this way until you have incorporated all 10 stitches from the first pass triangle.

This completes first block.

Pick up 10 more stitches and continue across row until final 10 stitches and proceed as follows.

P2tog, p8, turn

K9

P2tog, P7, turn

Continue in this way, purling two together at the beginning of the row and having one stitch less with each dec row. When one stitch remains, turn and slip stitch onto left needle. This is what work should look like now

3rd Pass - Just Blocks Join third colour yarn. This is second row of blocks with no side triangles just blocks.

Pick up and purl 9 stitches, turn K10, turn P9, P2tog, turn

K10 turn

Continue like this until working all 10 stitches across the row from the block below. After the last P9, P2tog, do not turn. Pick up and purl another 10 stitches and work that block (the second one) and continue to the end of the row. See Photo 4.

Design note: Make a large buttonhole for the car seat strap. Buttonhole: Cast off 8st 1st row and cast 8st on 2nd row Repeat the second and third

passes for the desired length.

Last Pass - Finishing

To end, you will need triangles and your last row of blocks needs to be a second pass row. See Photo 5. With 1 stitch on the needle, P1 Pick up and purl 9 stitches along the side of the block below, turn K10

P2tog, K7, P2 tog, turn

Continue like this, purling 2 together at the beginning and the end of the row and having one less stitch on each dec. row, until you K2:

Turn and P1, P2tog, turn

K2, turn

P3tog

There is one stitch left. Pick and up purl 9 stitches as before and proceed with the second and third triangles etc. When you have 1 stitch left at the other side of the fabric, end off.


MAKING UP

Pick up stitches around the outside edges (circular needle or 1 edge at a time)

Approx 110 st on side edges and 55 st on end edges. Knit as many rows as required remembering to increase 1 st at the corners on each row so the corners

do not pull. Cast off. Sew corner edges together, and neaten any ends.



Cast off 7 (7, 8, 8, 9, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13) sts beg next 2 WS rows, then rem 7 (8, 7, 8, 8, 10, 11, 11, 12, 13) sts beg foll WS row.

SLEEVES

With 2.75mm needles and B, cast on 57 (62, 62, 62, 67, 67, 67, 72, 72, 72) sts.

Change to A.

Row 1: RS – P2; *k3, p2; rep from * to end.

Row 2: K2; *p3, k2; rep from * to end.

Rep last 2 rows for 6 (7, 7, 7, 7, 7.5 7.5, 7.5, 7.5, 7.5) cm, end with a WS row.

Change to 3.25mm needles. A, Stst O (2, 2, 0, 0, 0, 0, 2, 0, 2) rows.

Work in Stst and Stripe patt until piece measures approx 43 (44.5, 44.5, 45, 45, 46, 46, 46, 47, 47)cm from beg, ensure to end with same row and colour as body to underarms, AND AT SAME TIME, inc 1 st each end every 7 (7, 7, 7, 7, 7, 6, 6, 6, 6)th row 17 (16, 18, 19, 18, 19, 21, 20, 21, 23) times to 91 (94, 98, 100, 103, 105, 109, 112, 114, 118) sts.

Shape Underarm and Top

Keeping Stripe patt correct, cast off 7 (7, 7, 8, 8, 9, 9, 9, 9, 9) sts beg next 2 rows.

Next Rows: RS – K2, k2tog, k to last 4 sts, skp, k2.

P 1 row.

Cont to dec every RS row as established 17 (18, 20, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28) more times – 41 (42, 42, 38, 39, 37, 39, 40, 40, 42) sts.

Next Rows: RS – K2, skp, k to last 4 sts, k2tog, k2.

Next Rows: P2, p2tog, p to last 4 sts, p2tog-tbl, p2.

Rep last 2 rows 3 (3, 3, 2, 2, 2, 2, 2, 2, 2, 2, 2) times more – 25 (26, 26, 26, 27, 25, 27, 28, 28, 30) sts.

Cast off 4 sts beg next 4 rows – 9 (10, 10, 10, 11, 9, 11, 12, 12, 14) sts.

Cast off loosely rem sts.

MAKING UP

Join fronts to back at shoulders.

BUTTON AND BUTTONHOLE BAND

With RS facing, 2.75mm needles (or circular needle) and B, beg at right front cast on edge, pick up and k100 (101, 104, 108, 108, 108, 110, 111, 109, 111) sts to neck marker, pick up and k78 (81, 84, 84, 87, 90, 92, 94, 97, 99) sts to shoulder seam, k the back neck holder 38 (42, 46, 50, 52, 54, 54, 56, 58, 58) sts, pick up and k78 (81, 84, 84, 87, 90, 92, 94, 97, 99) sts down to front neck marker, k100 (101, 104, 108, 108, 108, 110, 111, 109, 111) sts down to cast on edge. 394 (406, 422, 434, 442, 450, 458, 466, 470, 478) sts.

Next Rows: WS – K all sts.

Change to A.

Next Rows: RS - K2; *p2, k2; rep from * to end.

Next Rows: P2; *k2, p2; rep from * to end.

Rib 3 more rows.

Next Rows: WS – Rib 5; cast off 2 sts, rib until there are 5 (5, 5, 5, 6, 6, 6, 6, 6, 6, 6) sts on needle, cast off 2 sts; (rib until there are 19 (19, 20, 21, 16, 16, 17, 17, 17, 17) sts on needle, cast off 2 sts) 4 (4, 4, 4, 5, 5, 5, 5, 5, 5) times; rib to end of row. Next Rows: Rib across and cast on 2 sts over cast-off sts of previous row. Rib 4 more rows.

Change to B.

Next Rows: WS – P all sts. Cast off loosely in rib on RS. Set in sleeves, join side and sleeve seams. Sew on buttons.

Break off C2. Round 4: Using M, 3ch, 1tr in each of next 2tr, (2tr, 2ch, 2tr) in corner 2ch sp, * 1tr in each of next 12tr, (2tr, 2ch, 2tr) in next corner 2ch sp *, rep

next 9tr, slst in 3rd ch at beg. Round 5: 3ch, 1tr in each of next 4tr, (2tr, 2ch, 2tr) in corner 2ch sp, * 1tr in each of next 16tr, (2tr, 2ch, 2tr) in next corner 2ch sp *, rep from * to * twice more, 1tr in each of next 11tr,

slst in 3rd ch at beg. Fasten off.

from * to * twice more, 1tr in each of

MOTIF B (MAKE 5)

Work as for Motif A, using C2 for 1st and 2nd rounds, C1 for 3rd round and M for 4th and 5th rounds. Fasten off.

MAKING UP

Edging

Using a flat seam, sew motifs together to form a piece 4 motifs wide x 5 motifs long, placing one each of Motif B at random in each row.

With right side facing, using 4.50mm hook and M, work 1 row of treble evenly around all sides, working 3 tr in each corner, slst in first st at beg. Fasten off M. With right side facing, using C2 – work another round of treble, using C1 – work one round of double crochet, then using M – work another round of treble, working 3 sts in each corner of every round to keep work flat.

Fasten off. Darn in all ends neatly on wrong side.

Row 7: K14, (K2tog, yfwd) twice, K1, (yfwd, sl 1, K1, psso) twice, K14.

Row 9: K13, (K2tog, yfwd) twice, K3, (yfwd, sl 1, K1, psso) twice, K13.

Row 11: K12, (K2tog, yfwd) 3 times, K1, (yfwd, sl 1, K1, psso) 3 times, K12.

Row 13: K11, (K2tog, yfwd) 3 times, K3, (yfwd, sl 1, K1, psso) 3 times, K11.

Row 15: K10, (K2tog, yfwd) 4 times,

K1, (yfwd, sl 1, K1, psso) 4 times, K10.

Row 17: K9, (K2tog, yfwd) 4 times, K3, (yfwd, sl 1, K1, psso) 4 times, K9. Row 19: K8, (K2tog, yfwd) 4 times, K5, (yfwd, sl 1, K1, psso) 4 times, K8. Row 21: K7, (K2tog, yfwd) 4 times, K1, yfwd, sl 1, K1, psso, K1, K2tog, yfwd, K1, (yfwd, sl 1, K1, psso) 4 times, K7.

Row 23: K6, (K2tog, yfwd) 4 times, K3, yfwd, sl 1, K2tog, psso, yfwd, K3, (yfwd, sl 1, K1, psso) 4 times, K6. **Row 25:** K5, (K2tog, yfwd) 4 times, K11, (yfwd, sl 1, K1, psso) 4 times, K5.

Row 27: K4, (K2tog, yfwd) 4 times, K1, (yfwd, sl 1, K1, psso, K1, K2tog, yfwd, K1) twice, (yfwd, sl 1, K1, psso) 4 times, K4.

Row 29: K3, (K2tog, yfwd) 4 times, (K3, yfwd, sl 1, K2tog, psso, yfwd) twice, K3, (yfwd, sl 1, K1, psso) 4 times, K3.

Row 31: K2, (K2tog, yfwd) 4 times, K17, (yfwd, sl 1, K1, psso) 4 times, K2.

Row 33: K4, (yfwd, sl 1, K1, psso) 4 times, (K1, K2tog, yfwd, K1, yfwd, sl 1, K1, psso) twice, K1, (K2tog, yfwd) 4 times, K4.

Row 35: K5, (yfwd, sl 1, K1, psso) 3 times, (yfwd, sl 1, K2tog, psso, yfwd, K3) twice, yfwd, sl 1, K2tog, psso, yfwd, (K2tog, yfwd) 3 times, K5.

Row 37: K6, (yfwd, sl 1, K1, psso) 4 times, K9, (K2tog, yfwd) 4 times, K6.

Row 39: K7, (yfwd, sl 1, K1, psso) 4 times, K1, K2tog, yfwd, K1, yfwd, sl 1, K1, psso, K1, (K2tog, yfwd) 4 times, K7.

Row 41: K8, (yfwd, sl 1, K1, psso) 3 times, yfwd, sl 1, K2tog, psso, yfwd, K3, yfwd, sl 1, K2tog, psso, yfwd, (K2tog, yfwd) 3 times, K8.

Row 43: K9, (yfwd, sl 1, K1, psso) 4 times, K3, (K2tog, yfwd) 4 times, K9. **Row 45:** K10, (yfwd, sl 1, K1, psso) 4 times, K1, (K2tog, yfwd) 4 times, K10.

Row 47: K11, (yfwd, sl 1, K1, psso) 3 times, yfwd, sl 1, K2tog, psso, yfwd, (K2tog, yfwd) 3 times, K11.

Row 49: K12, (yfwd, sl 1, K1, psso) 3 times, K1, (K2tog, yfwd) 3 times, K12.

Row 51: K13, (yfwd, sl 1, K1, psso) twice, yfwd, sl 1, K2tog, psso, yfwd, (K2tog, yfwd) twice, K13.

Row 53: K14, (yfwd, sl 1, K1, psso) twice, K1, (K2tog, yfwd) twice, K14. **Row 55:** K15, yfwd, sl 1, K1, psso, yfwd, sl 1, K2tog, psso, yfwd, K2tog, yfwd, K15.

Row 57: K16, yfwd, sl 1, K1, psso, K1, K2tog, yfwd, K16.

Row 59: As row 3.

Row 61: Knit.

WORKING PATTERN BLANKET

Using 3.25mm needles, cast on 209 sts.

Note: If this number of sts does not fit comfortably on a pair of needles, we suggest using a circular needle. Work backwards and forwards in rows.

Row 5: K3, P3, work row 5 of Lace Diamond across next 37 sts, P3, (K37, P3) 3 times, work row 5 of Lace Diamond across next 37 sts, P3, K3. Row 6: P3, K3, work row 6 of Lace Diamond across next 37 sts, K3, (P37, K3) 3 times, work row 6 of Lace Diamond across next 37 sts, K3, P3.

Keeping patt and lace diamonds correct as placed in last 6 rows, work a further 55 rows patt (beg with 7th row of Lace Diamond), completing diamonds. 61 rows patt in all. ***

Rep from ** to ** once.

Beg Main Patt

Row 1: K3, P3, * K37, P3, rep from * to last 3 sts, K3.

Row 2: P3, K3, * P37, K3, rep from * to last 3 sts, P3.

Last 2 rows form main patt. Rep last 2 rows 29 times, then 1st row once. 61 rows main patt in all.

Next Row: WS - P3, (K3, P37) twice, K43, (P37, K3) twice, P3.

Next Row: K3, (P3, K37) twice, P43, (K37, P3) twice, K3.

Next Row: P3, (K3, P37) twice, K43, (P37, K3) twice, P3.

Place Centre Lace Diamond

Row 1: K3, P3, (K37, P3) 5 times, K3.

Row 2: P3, K3, (P37, K3) 5 times, P3. Row 3: K3, P3, (K37, P3) twice, work row 3 of Lace Diamond across next 37 sts, (P3, K37) twice, P3, K3.

Row 4: P3, K3, (P37, K3) twice, work row 4 of Lace Diamond across next 37 sts, (K3, P37) twice, K3, P3.

Row 5: K3, P3, (K37, P3) twice, work row 5 of Lace Diamond across next 37 sts, (P3, K37) twice, P3, K3. **Row 6:** P3, K3, (P37, K3) twice, work

row 6 of Lace Diamond across next 37 sts, (K3, P37) twice, K3, P3. Keeping patt and lace diamond correct as placed in last 6 rows, work a further 55 rows patt (beg with 7th row of Lace Diamond), completing diamond. 61 rows patt in all.

Next Row: WS - P3, (K3, P37) twice, K43, (P37, K3) twice, P3.

Next Row: K3, (P3, K37) twice, P43, (K37, P3) twice, K3.

Next Row: P3, (K3, P37) twice, K43, (P37, K3) twice, P3.

Work 61 rows of Main Patt (as before).

Rep from ** to ** once.

Place Corner Lace Diamonds

Rep from *** to *** once. Rep from ** to ** once. Cast off knitways.

MAKING UP

Thread in ends. Do not press.

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Ladybirds are the gentle friends of the garden. Give this set to a growing friend of the little kind.

Rib (as per row 1) 3, yfwd K2tog, rib 11, yfwd K2tog, rib 11 yfwd k2tog, K2.

Continuing as per row 4, knit as per pattern until piece measures 42 (44, 45) cm.

Cast off in rib.

Sew Ladybird buttons in place.

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

Next Row: Cast off 3(4, 5, 5, 6, 6)sts in rib, rib to end. 15(17, 19,21, 23, 26)sts.

Next Row: rib.

Work 4(4, 4, 4, 6, 6) rows dec 1 st at neck edge in every row. 11(13, 15, 17, 17, 20) sts

Work 5(5, 7, 7, 5, 5) rows dec 1 st at neck edge in next and every foll alt row. 8(10, 11, 13, 14, 17) sts.

Cont without shaping until armhole measure 10(11, 12, 13, 14, 15) cm ending with a RS row.

Shape Shoulder

Next Row: Cast off 4(5, 5, 6, 7, 8)sts in rib, rib to end. 4(5, 6, 7, 7, 9)

Next Row: Rib.

Cast off rem 4(5, 6, 7, 7, 9) in rib.

LONG SLEEVES – BOTH ALIKE

Using 3.25mm needles and thumb method cast on 39(39, 43, 45, 51, 53)sts work 5 rows in 1x1 rib. **Row 6:** P1(1, 3, 4, 7, 8), (p2tog, p5) 5 times, p2 tog, p1,(1, 3, 4, 7, 8).

33(33, 37, 39, 45, 47)sts. Change to 4mm needles and working in st.st inc 1 st at each end of 5th and every foll 12th(6th, 6th, 8th, 12, 12th) row to 39(45, 43, 53, 55, 61)sts.

For 3rd and 5th sizes only

Inc 1 st at each end of every foll (8th, 14th) row to (49, 57)sts

For all 6 sizes

Cont without shaping until sleeve measures 15(17, 20, 24, 29, 33)cm, or length required, ending with a WS row.

Shape Sleeve Top

Cast off 2(2, 3, 3, 4, 4) sts at beg of next 2 rows. 35(41, 43, 47, 49, 53)sts Work 4(6, 6, 8, 6, 6)rows dec 1 st at each end of every row. 27(29, 31, 31, 27, 41)sts Work 4(6, 8, 8, 8, 10, 10) rows dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll alt ro. 23(23, 23, 23, 27, 31) ara
Work 4(4, 4, 4, 6, 8) rows dec 1 st at each end of every row. 15sts.
Cast off 4sts at beg of next 2 rows.
7sts.

Cast off rem 7sts.

SHORT SLEEVES - BOTH ALIKE

Using 3.25mm needles and thumb method cast on 33(39, 43, 47, 51, 55)sts, work 4 rows in 1x1 rib Change to 4mm needles and working in st.st work 2 rows.

Shape Sleeve Top

Cast off 2(2, 3, 3, 4, 4)sts at beg of next 2 rows. 29(35, 37, 41, 43, 47)sts Work 2(2, 2, 2, 2, 4)rows dec 1 st at each end of every row. 25(31, 33, 37, 39, 39)sts

Work 8(12, 14, 14, 16, 16) rows dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll alt row. 17(19, 19, 23, 23, 23)sts. Work 2(2, 2, 4, 4, 4)rows dec 1 st at each end of every row. 13(15, 15, 15, 15, 15)sts.

Cast off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows. 7(9, 9, 9, 9) sts
Cast off rem 7(9, 9, 9, 9) sts

NECKBAND

Join shoulder seams. With RS facing, using 3.25mm needles pick up and knit 23(25, 26, 28, 29, 31)sts evenly along right side of neck, 25(27, 31, 31, 35, 35)sts from 26(28, 32, 32, 36, 36)cast off sts at back of neck and 23(25, 26, 28, 29, 31)sts evenly along left side of neck. 71(77, 83, 87, 93, 97)sts.

Starting with Row 1 of 1x1 rib work 5 rows.

Cast off in rib.

RIGHT FRONT BORDER

With RS facing using 3.25mm needles pick up and knit 5sts evenly along rib, 24(34, 41, 51, 59,71)sts evenly along front edge of start of ribbed yoke, 13(13, 16, 16, 20, 20)sts along ribbed yoke and 5sts evenly along neckband. 47(57, 67, 77, 89, 101)sts.

Starting with a Row 2 of 1x1 rib work 2 rows.

Next Row: rib 3, cast off 1 st, (rib 10(10, 11, 11, 8, 8), cast of 1 st) 1(1, 1, 1, 2, 2) times, rib to end.

Next Row: rib 31(41, 50, 60, 65, 77) cast on 1 st (rib 11(11, 12, 12, 12, 9, 9) cast on 1 st) 1(1, 1, 1, 2, 2) times, rib 3.

Work 2 rows more in rib.

Cast off in rib.

LEFT FRONT BORDER

With RS facing using 3.25mm needles pick up and knit 5sts evenly along neck band, 13(13, 16, 16, 20, 20)

sts along ribbed yoke 24(34, 41, 51, 59,71)sts evenly along front edge and 5sts evenly along rib. 47(57, 67, 77, 89, 101)sts.

Starting with a Row 2 of 1x1 rib work 6 rows.

Cast off in rib.

FLOWER

Using 3.25mm needles and thumb method cast on 55sts.

Row 1: * k1, cast off 9sts (1 st remains on needle) rep from * to end. 10sts.


Break off yarn, run yarn though rem sts, draw up and fasten off.

MAKING UP

Fold sleeves in half lengthways, then placing folds to shoulder seams sew sleeves in position. Join side and sleeve seams. Sew on flower. Sew on buttons. Pin garment to measurements, cover with damp cloths and leave to dry.

GETTING STARTED

Turning: Rows are not always worked from end to end. They can be stopped at any point and then turned and worked backwards.

When instructed to turn, simply turn the knitting around by swapping the needles to the other hands ready to work back in the other direction (this will be considered to be the next row). When pattern specifies turn' - proceed as follows (to avoid holes in work) -

take yarn under needle and onto other side of work, slip next st onto right hand needle, take yarn under needle and back to original position, slip st back onto left hand needle, then turn and proceed as instructed in pattern.

WORKING PATTERN BACK

Using 4.00mm needles, cast on 79(83, 91, 95, 103, 107) sts.

Begin Pattern For Back

Row 1: P3, *K1, P3, rep from * to end.

Row 2: K3, *P1, K3, rep from * to end.

Last 2 rows form patt.

Cont in patt until work measures
18(20, 23, 26, 28, 33) cm from beg,
ending with a 2nd patt row.

Work 16 rows patt.

Shape Raglan Armholes

Keeping patt correct, cast off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows. 75(79, 87, 91, 99, 103) sts.

Dec one st at each end of next and foll alt rows until 63 (65, 73, 75, 79, 81) sts rem, then in every row until 21 (23, 23, 25, 25, 27) sts rem. Cast off rem 21 (23, 23, 25, 25, 27) sts in patt.

LEFT FRONT

Using 4.00mm needles, cast on 43 (45, 49, 51, 55, 57) sts.

Begin Pattern For Left Front

Row 1: *P3, K1, rep from * to last 7(9, 9, 7, 11, 9) sts, P1(3, 2, 0, 3, 1), K6(6, 7, 7, 8, 8).

Row 2: P3, K3(3, 4, 4, 5, 5), K1(3, 2, 0, 3, 1), *P1, K3, rep from * to end. Last 2 rows form patt.

Cont in patt until work measures 18(20, 23, 26, 28, 33) cm from beg, ending with a 2nd patt row.

Next Row: Button hole row - Patt to last 5(5, 6, 6, 6, 6) sts, yfwd (to make a stitch), K2tog, K3(3, 4, 4, 4, 4).

Work a further 13 rows patt, beg with a 2nd row.

Next Row: Button hole row - Patt to last 5(5, 6, 6, 6, 6) sts, yfwd (to make a

stitch), K2tog, K3(3, 4, 4, 4, 4). Work 1 row patt.

Begin Armhole and Collar Shaping

Row 1: Cast off 2 sts, patt to last 8(8, 9, 9, 10, 10) sts, patt 2tog, inc in next st, K2(2, 3, 3, 4, 4), P3. 41(43, 47, 49, 53, 55) sts.

Row 2: K7(7, 8, 8, 9, 9), patt to end.

Row 3: Patt 2tog, patt to last 7(7, 8, 8, 9, 9) sts, K4(4, 5, 5, 6, 6), P3. 40(42, 46, 48, 52, 54) sts.

Row 4: As 2nd row.

Row 5: Patt 2tog, patt to last 9(9, 10, 10, 11, 11) sts, patt 2tog, inc in next st, K3(3, 4, 4, 5, 5), P3. 39(41, 45, 47, 51, 53) sts.

Row 6: K8(8, 9, 9, 10, 10), patt to end.

Row 7: Patt 2tog, patt to last 8(8, 9, 9, 10, 10) sts, K5(5, 6, 6, 7, 7), P3. 38(40, 44, 46, 50, 52) sts.

Row 8: As 6th row.

Row 9: Patt 2tog, patt to last 10(10, 11, 11, 12, 12) sts, patt 2tog, inc in next st, K4(4, 5, 5, 6, 6), P3. 37(39, 43, 45, 49, 51) sts.

Row 10: K9(9, 10, 10, 11, 11), patt to end.

Keeping front collar correct, cont shaping in this manner dec one st at armhole edge in next and foll alt rows 1 (3, 3, 4, 6, 7) times, then in every row 21 (21, 25, 25, 27, 27) times AT SAME TIME dec one st (as before) in 3rd and foll 4th rows 6 (6, 5, 6, 5, 6) times and inc one st (as before) in 3rd and foll 4th rows 6 (6, 7, 6, 8, 7) times,

Sizes 2, 4, 6, 8 and 10 only in foll alt rows: (1, 1, 4, 3, 6) times.

All Sizes: 15(16, 18, 20, 22, 24) sts.

Shape Collar

Keeping patt correct, cont on these 15(16, 18, 20, 22, 24) sts for collar. Work 3 rows patt.

Begin Turnings

Row 1: Patt 11(12, 14, 16, 18, 20) turn.

Row 2: Patt to end.

Patt 2 rows across all sts.
Rep last 4 rows 11(12, 13, 14, 15, 16) times.

Next Row: Patt to end. Cast off loosely in patt.

RIGHT FRONT

Using 4.00mm needles, cast on 43 (45, 49, 51, 55, 57) sts.

Begin Pattern For Right Front

Row 1: K6(6, 7, 7, 8, 8), P1(3, 2, 0, 3, 1), *K1, P3, rep from * to end. Row 2: *K3, P1, rep from * to last 7(9, 9, 7, 11, 9) sts, K1(3, 2, 0, 3, 1), K3(3, 4, 4, 5, 5), P3. Last 2 rows form patt. Cont in patt until work measures 18(20, 23, 26, 28, 33) cm from beg, ending with a 2nd patt row. Work a further 16 rows patt.

Begin Armhole and Collar Shaping

Row 1: P3, K2(2, 3, 3, 4, 4), inc in next st, patt 2tog, patt to end.

Row 2: Cast off 2 sts, patt to last 7 (7, 8, 8, 9, 9) sts, knit to end. 41 (43, 47, 49, 53, 55) sts.

Row 3: P3, K4(4, 5, 5, 6, 6), patt to last 2 sts, patt 2tog. 40(42, 46, 48, 52, 54) sts.

Row 4: Patt to last 7 (7, 8, 8, 9, 9) sts, knit to end.

Row 5: P3, K3(3, 4, 4, 5, 5), inc in next st, patt 2tog, patt to last 2 sts, patt 2tog. 39(41, 45, 47, 51, 53) sts.

Row 6: Patt to last 8(8, 9, 9, 10, 10) sts knit to end.

Row 7: P3, K5(5, 6, 6, 7, 7), patt to last 2 sts, patt 2tog. 38 (40, 44, 46, 50, 52) sts.

Row 8: As 6th row.

Row 9: P3, K4(4, 5, 5, 6, 6), inc in next st, patt 2tog, patt to last 2 sts, patt 2tog. 37(39, 43, 45, 49, 51) sts. **Row 10:** Patt to last 9(9, 10, 10, 11, 11) sts, knit to end.

Keeping patt correct, cont shaping in this manner dec one st at armhole edge in next and foll alt rows 1(3, 3, 4, 6, 7) times, then in every row 21 (21, 25, 25, 27, 27) times AT SAME TIME dec one st (as before) in 3rd and foll 4th rows 6(6, 5, 6, 5, 6) times and inc one st (as before) in 3rd and foll 4th rows 6(6, 7, 6, 8, 7) times,

Sizes 2, 4, 6, 8 and 10 only in foll **alt rows:** (1, 1, 4, 3, 6) times.

All Sizes: 15(16, 18, 20, 22, 24) sts.

Shape Collar

Keeping patt correct, cont on these 15(16, 18, 20, 22, 24) sts for collar. Work 2 rows patt.

Begin Turnings:

Row 1: Patt 11(12, 14, 16, 18, 20) turn.

Row 2: Patt to end.

Work 2 rows patt across all sts. Rep last 4 rows 12(13, 14, 15, 16, 17) times.

Next row: Patt to end. Cast off in patt.

SLEEVES

Using 4.00mm needles, cast on 39(41, 43, 45, 47, 49) sts.

Begin Sleeve Pattern

Row 1: P3(0, 1, 2, 3, 0), K1, *P3, K1, rep from * to last 3 (0, 1, 2, 3, 0) sts, P3 (0, 1, 2, 3, 0).

Row 2: K3(0, 1, 2, 3, 0), P1, *K3,

P1, rep from * to last 3 (0, 1, 2, 3, 0) sts, K3(0, 1, 2, 3, 0).

Last 2 rows form patt for sleeves. Cont in patt, working extra sts into patt, inc one st at each end of 5th rows and foll 6th (4th, 6th, 6th, 6th, 4th) rows until there are 53 (55, 63, 61, 67, 55) sts, then in foll 8th (6th, 8th, 8th, 8th, 6th) rows until there are 55(63, 65, 69, 75, 81) sts.

Cont in patt (without further inc) until work measures 21 (23, 28, 33, 38, 38) cm from beg, ending with a wrong side row.

Shape Top

Keeping patt correct, cast off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows. 51(59, 61, 65, 71, 77) sts.

Dec one st at each end of next and foll alt rows until 27 (39, 33, 37, 35, 37) sts rem, then in every row until 9(9, 11, 11, 11, 11) sts rem. Cast off rem sts.

MAKING UP

Using a flat seam join raglan seams, noting that tops of sleeves form part of neckline. Join side and sleeve seams. Join collar seam at centre back and sew rem collar into position. Sew on buttons.

GLOSSARY

BEGINNER'S TOOL KIT

PINS

Plastic-head pins are useful for checking tension and blocking out



items. Pins with coloured heads are best because they do not get lost in your work.

KNITTING NEEDLES

Knitting needles are made from plastic, aluminium or wood and come in varying lengths and widths. Straight needles come in pairs and doublepointed needles come in sets of four.

KNITTING BAG

A knitting bag is essential for those who like to knit 'on the go'. Not only is it a practical way to keep all your knitting paraphenalia together, it also helps keep the yarn clean and tangle-free.



ROW COUNTER

A row counter is helpful for keeping track of rows worked, particularly where increases, decreases or other kinds of patterning occur.



CIRCULAR KNITTING NEEDLES

Circular needles have two working ends joined by a thin nylon wire. They are more balanced than straight needles and allow the weight of your work to rest in your lap.



KNITTING IN ELASTIC

Elastic yarn prevents sagging in cuffs, collars and waists. You can work it in with knitting yarn on knitted or crocheted garments.

TAPE MEASURE

A basic tape measure is essential for checking your garment measurements.



KNITTER'S NEEDLES

Knitter's needles need to have a large eye and a blunt point so they do not split stitches when sewing up your knitting.




STITCH GAUGE

A stitch gauge is a flat piece of metal or plastic with a ruler marked on one side and/or a window

cut out in the centre. It allows you to mark and measure easily and accurately.

STITCH HOLDER

A stitch holder is used to secure stitches not in use. You can also use safety pins for holding a small number of stitches.




CASTING ON

Casting on is creating a row of loops on a knitting needle to form the base row for your knitting. One of the most popular methods of casting on is the cable cast on. Form a slipknot about 25cm away from the end of the yarn.

Place the slipknot on a knitting needle and pull gently to secure. Hold this needle in your left hand. Insert the right-hand needle through the slip knot. Pass the yarn over the point of the right-hand needle (see Diagram 1).

Pull a loop through the slip knot with the right-hand needle (see Diagram 2). Place this loop on the left-hand needle and gently pull the yarn to secure the stitch. For the remaining cast-on stitches, insert the right-hand needle between the slip knot and the first stitch on the left-hand needle. Wind the yarn around the point of the right-hand needle. Draw a loop through and place this loop on the left-hand needle. Continue in this manner until you have cast on the desired number of stitches.

KNIT STITCH



Once you have cast on, you then knit into the stitches you have made to form the knitted fabric. Hold the needle with the cast on stitches in your left hand, with the loose yarn at the back of your work. Insert the right-hand needle from left to right through the front of the first stitch on the left-hand needle (see Diagram 1). Wind the yarn from left to right over the point of the right-hand needle (see Diagram 2). Draw the

yarn through the stitch to form a new stitch on the right-hand needle. Slip the original stitch off the left-hand needle, keeping the new stitch on the right-hand needle. To knit a row, repeat these steps until all the stitches have been transferred from the left-hand needle to the right-hand needle. Turn your work, transferring the needle with the stitches on into your left hand to work the next row.

PURL STITCH




The purl stitch is basically the reverse of the knit stitch. Hold the needle with the stitches on in your left hand, with the loose yarn at the front of your work. Insert the right-hand needle from right to left into the front of the first stitch on the left-hand needle (see Diagram 1). Wind the yarn from right to left over the point of the right-hand needle (see Diagram 2). Draw the yarn through the

stitch to form a new stitch on the right-hand needle. Slip the original stitch off the left-hand needle, keeping the new stitch on the right-hand needle. To purl a row, repeat these steps until all the stitches have been transferred from the left-hand needle to the right-hand needle. Turn your work, transferring the needle with the stitches on into your left hand to work the next row.

CASTING OFF

KNITWISE

Knit two stitches. Use the point of the left-hand needle to lift the first stitch on the right-hand needle over the second, and drop if off the needle. Knit the next stitch on the left-hand needle so that there are two stitches on the right-hand needle again, and repeat. Continue in this manner




until all the stitches have been worked off the left-hand needle and only one stitch remains on the right-hand needle. Cut the yarn, leaving a tail and thread the yarn through the loop and pull it firmly to fasten off.

PURLWISE

Purl two stitches. Use the point of the left-hand needle to lift the first stitch on the right-hand needle over the second, and drop it off the needle.

Purl the next stitch on the left-hand needle so that there are two stitches on the right-hand needle again, and



repeat. Continue in this manner until all the stitches have been worked off the left-hand needle and only one stitch remains on the right-hand needle. Secure this last stitch as described in casting off knitwise.

SUBSTITUTING YARNS

If you substitute or spin a yarn for a project, you can compare the weight of the yarn to the project yarn by comparing wraps per inch. Wrap your yarn around a ruler for one inch and count the number of wraps. If you have more wraps per inch than the project yarn, your yarn is too thin; if you have fewer wraps per inch than the project yarn, your yarn is too thin; the project yarn, your yarn is too thick.



KNITTING TENSION

Checking your knitting tension, that is, the tightness or looseness of your knitting, is important. To check your tension, cast on 30 stitches using the recommended needle size.

Work in the pattern until your work measures 10cm from the cast on edge then cast off. You now have a "swatch". Measure your tension by placing a ruler over your swatch and counting the number of stitches


across and rows down (including fractions of stitches and rows) in 10cm. Repeat these measurements two to three times on a different parts of the swatch to check your measurements. If you have more stitches and rows than called for in the instructions, you should use larger needles; if you have fewer, use smaller needles. Check your tension again before starting your project.


PROVISIONAL CAST ON (INVISIBLE CAST ON)

Place a loose slipknot on the needle in your right hand. Hold the waste yarn next to the slipknot and around your left thumb. Hold your working yarn over your left index finger.

*Bring the needle forward under the waste yarn, over the working yarn, grab a loop of working yarn (Diagram

1), then bring the needle to the front, over both yarns, and grab a second loop (Diagram 2). Repeat from * until you have the desired number of stitches on your needle. When you're ready to work in the opposite direction, pick out the waste yarn to expose the live stitches.





BACKSTITCH


This is the stitch most commonly used for joining knitted garments. With the right sides of your work together, pin the knitted fabric together with the edges even. The seam should be sewn one full stitch from the end of the row. One stitch should be worked over every row. Thread the yarn needle. Insert the needle through both layers and sew two stitches to the left then one stitch back to the right. Keep stitches at an even distance. Continue working from right to left in this circular motion. (Diagram 1)

TASSELS


Cut yarn twice the length of your desired tassel plus a bit extra for the knot. According to the desired thickness of the tassel, select a number of lengths of yarn. Fold the lengths of yarn in half over a crochet hook. On the wrong side, insert the crochet hook from the front to the back through the edge of the work. Grab the yarn and pull through and tighten. Trim the ends to the same length.

KNOTTED FRINGE

After working a tassel, take one half of the strands from each tassel and knot them with half the strands from the neighbouring tassel. Trim.




CROCHET CHAIN




Make a slip knot on your hook. Pass the yarn over the hook and catch it with the hook and draw it through the loop on the hook. Repeat, drawing yarn through the last loop formed.


DOUBLE CROCHET (DC) (US SINGLE **CROCHET SC)**




Insert the hook through the top two loops of a stitch. Pass the yarn over the hook and draw up a loop so that you have two loops on the hook (Diagram 1). Pass the yarn over the hook and draw through both loops on the hook (Diagram 2). Continue in the same way, inserting the hook into each stitch (Diagram 3).


HALF TREBLE CROCHET (HTR) (US HALF DOUBLE CROCHET HDC)





Pass the yarn over the hook. Insert the hook through the top two loops of a stitch (Diagram 1). Pass the yarn over the hook and draw up a loop so that there are three loops on the hook (Diagram 2). Draw through all three loops on the hook (Diagram 3).







SLIP STITCH CROCHET (SL ST)

Insert your hook into the stitch. Yarn over the hook and draw the loop through the stitch and loop onto the hook.






Pass the yarn over the hook. Insert the hook through the top two loops of a stitch (Diagram 1). Pass the yarn over the hook and draw up a loop so that you have three loops on the hook (Diagram 2). Pass the yarn over the hook and draw it through the first two loops on the hook, pass the yarn over the hook and draw through the remaining two loops. Continue in the same way, inserting the hook into each stitch (Diagram 3).



I-CORD

With double-pointed needles, cast on the desired number of stitches. *Without turning the needle, slide the stitches to the other end of the needle, pull the yarn around the back and knit the stitches as usual. Repeat from * until your work measures the desired length




PICKING UP DROPPED STITCHES

A dropped stitch can be picked up using a crochet hook and don't be put off by stitches that have unraveled several rows down into the work. To pick up knit stitches, insert the crochet hook into the dropped stitch, draw through the bar lying above the dropped stitch and pull it through the loop of the dropped stitch.
